Item I leave the use of my pecora pasture called ~~Spring~~ ^{Spring} pasture unto my dearly beloved wife and my son Nathaniel Burger and John Burger and for them to leave it in good repair when my son Nathaniel Burger comes of age I also leave the use of the remainder of my pecora land which is not under a fence unto my wife and my son John Burger until my son Nathaniel Burger comes of age and then I give and bequeath unto my son Nathaniel Burger all my pecora land called ~~Spring~~ ^{Spring} pasture two hundred and six acres more or less to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Nathaniel Burger six hundred acres of land in Cumberland in the State of Georgia which I give my Executor lawful power to sell or swap the said lands for other land provided they think proper and if the Executor should sell the said land for them to purchase other land if they should have a convenient opportunity with the money they receive for the other said land to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give I bequeath to my son Nathaniel Burger a Cow & two swine which has been called his also One bed Furniture to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Burger a Colt named Dolphin also One Cow & two swine & two chickens also One bed Furniture to him his heirs and assigns forever and for none of the property to be sold.

Item I leave unto my dearly beloved wife the use of all the remainder of my property during her natural life and hereafter give and at her decease for my son John to have the Buffet bed now stands in the House and Chest called ~~mine~~ ^{mine} and bed new stand in the House and Chest called ~~mine~~ ^{mine} and my body Cash, and unto my son Nathaniel Burger at my wife's decease to have One bed Furniture also One Cow & three yearlings, and at my wife Susan I give all the remainder of my property unto my Daughter Mary Burger to her heirs and assigns forever. — And

And I further nominate and appoint my dearly beloved friends Josiah Outland and William Outland as Executors of this my last Will and Testament whereunto I have set my hand and Seal this the 23rd day of November in the year of our Lord 1798.

Sampson Revill's Will

In the name of God Amen I Sampson Revill of Northampton County in the State of North Carolina being at present in perfect health of body and of good and sound memory thanks be to God and calling to mind the mortality of my body do give and bequeath my goods and chattels in manner hereinafter following to wit: My will and desire is that all my just debts should be paid out of my estate.

Second. Item I leave unto my loving wife Margaret Revill during her natural life the land and plantation whereon I now live also all my household and kitchen furniture likewise all my stock of Cattle Hogs, Horses and Sheep after the death of my loving wife I give unto my son Sampson Revill the land & plantation whereon I now live that is to say One hundred acres, second I give unto my son Matthew Revill the land and plantation whereon he now lives that is to say One hundred acres, if there is more land then each part in Land I desire that the balance may be divided between my two sons Sampson & Matthew. Third I give unto my son Matthew all my Carpenter tools also I give to my two sons my hand mill and Crops cut Saw to Matthew & Sampson.

Fourthly After the death of my loving wife I give all my
Black Household & Kitchen furniture to my Grand Children
that is to say the Children of Lazarus Reville Humphrey
Reville Matthew Reville Sally Moore Temperance Jarvis
Randolph Reville to be equally divided amongst them

I give unto my Daughter Temperance Jarvis five shillings also
I give unto my Son Randolph Reville five shillings
I give unto my Son John Reville five shillings also
I give unto my Daughter Sally Reville five shillings

it is appointed for me to die do hereby make, declare this my last Will and

Land with the use thereof but in case of marriage only one third part

to be equally divided to each his part at the death of my Wife

I give to my wife Susannah Jacob all my stock and all household
furniture and plantation utensils during her widowhood but in
case she marries to have one child's part

I give to my Son Samuel One Dollar or the value thereof

I give to my Son James Jacob One Dollar or the value thereof

I give to my Son Jacob Jacob One Dollar or the value thereof

I give to my Son William Jacob One Dollar or the value thereof

I give to my Daughters Mary & Elizabeth and Margaret and
Sarah and Rebecca Jacob One Dollar for each or the value thereof

I give to my three Children viz. Minerva and Rebecca and
John Jacob the remainder of my personal estate to be equally
divided to each their parts at the marriage or decease of my wife
