Item I give and bequeath unto my Brother John Webb the land whereon I now live One bed and furniture also my Stock of Hogs and Stock of Cows to him and his Heirs forever.

I do likewise constitute and appoint my Brother Will Webb my whole and sole executor of this my last will and Testament appointing this and no other to be my last will & Testament.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son William Short One bed and furniture One walnut Table my stock of Hogs Cattle and Sheep and all the balance of my Negatives that I have not given away to him and his Heirs forever.

I do hereby constitute and appoint my son William Short Executor of this my last will and Testament making void all other will or Wills heretofore made by me.
