In the name of God Amen I Arthur Stephenson of Northampton County and State
of North Carolina being at this time of a disposing mind and memory thanks
be to God first being willing to write the last will of my body I have
that it is appointed for us that we do make and execute this my
last Will and Testament in the following manner and form.

First I will that all my actual debts be paid.

Mem I Give and bequeath unto my friend Dr William Stephenson five shillings
to him and his heirs forever.

Mem I Give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Lewis five shillings to her
and her heirs forever.

Mem I Give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Lewis five shillings to
her and her heirs forever.

Mem I Give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Lewis five pounds current
money of the State to her and her heirs forever.

Mem I Give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Lewis five pounds current
money of the State to her and her heirs forever.

Mem I Give and bequeath to my daughter Rachel Stephenson five pounds current
money of the State to her and her heirs forever.

Mem I Give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Coffin five pounds current
money of the State to her and her heirs forever.

Mem I Leave the residue of all my property and the balance of all the other part of my
estate to my wife as long as she lives a widow.

Mem I Give and bequeath unto my son Abraham Stephenson all the remainder
part of my estate of whatsoever kind it be to him and his heirs forever.

And I do appoint my son Abraham Stephenson my friend Benjamin
Dora and Jacob Dora joint Executors of this my last Will and Testament
writing and making void all other wills heretofore by me made In
Witness my Hand and Seal the 26th day of October 1794.
