but in perfect memory do make & ordain my last Will & Testament in the following manner & upon this
I give & recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it

I leave all my Land to my beloved Wife, Polly Summers & also
all my Negroes, my son, Son & minor during her lifetime to
support & maintain all my Children, till they arrive to mature
Age but in case my Wife should marry or become poor in my Will
it then my Will that all my Estate to be equally divided
between all my Legates except my Land which I give to my beloved
Son, William Summers & John Summers also all my Debt & debt that
my Executors shall or make of my Stock or other things, my first debt
I constituted & ordain appoint my truly friend & neighbor whole
& sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament & demanding
& receiving all other in the Will I have set my hand
witness this Fifth day of October the Thirtieth eight hundred
thirteen

of the State of North Carolina & County of Northampton being of sound mind
memory & perfect memory do this Thirtieth day of January in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred eight make & ordain
my last Will & Testament in manner following, (viz)

I leave unto my beloved Wife, Charlotte Coxins one third part of all my
said plantation & house I now live during the term of her natural
life to her only or heirs

I give & bequeath unto my son William Coxins son of my Brother
Joseph Coxins all my Land that lies in Northampton County by him
formerly to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath to William Coxins son of my Brother Thomas Coxins
all the Land bought of John Richards lying in Franklin County by the said
William Coxins formerly to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath unto Thomas Coxins son of my Brother Thomas
Coxins all the Land bought of William Hays lying in Franklin
County by him formerly to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath to my sister Elizabeth Coxins all the property which
is now in her possession by her formerly to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath to Jeremiah Battle all the property now in his hands
which I have sold of late by him formerly to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath to my daughter Nancy Coxins all the property
now in her hands & also paying to my Executors his debt due me by him
formerly to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath to Stephen Coffey one third part of all the property
arising from the Lands & Release of Simon Coffey in Roanoke River
District & bequeath to Stephen Coffey one third part of a claim
of money due me by late from Simon Coffey by him formerly to be
possessed & enjoyed forever
