my land of 100 Acres and Plantations which I have been to his heirs
and Heirs and from thence Give him my Runny Hill
and Blacksmith Shop and Carpenter Shop and the Land there
the said and premises he now has or has and the said house he
now has and my sister Hannah and my daughter and
Granddaughter. Now Give & bequeath unto my Daughter
Mary Hawley one half of the premises Give & bequeath unto my
grand daughter Charlotte Kinsman two thirds of the premises to be
paid out of my Estate Give & bequeath unto my Daughter
Cecilia Kinsman and my grand daughter Mary Hawley all the rest
of my Estate in and out of doors to be equally divided between them
Now I declare and declare my dear William Hawley my first Executor
and John Wilson my second Executor to this my last Will and
Testament Give and bequeath my land and house which I have offered my debt
this 1st day of July and therefore have hereunto set my hand and

the following Manner and Form. First Give & bequeath unto my
grand daughter Elizabeth Sawyer one half of the premises to be
paid out of my Estate Give & bequeath unto my grand daughter
Elizabeth Sawyer one half of the premises to be paid out of my Estate
and help of my Estate or said Estate also all my right & title
to the land whereon William Sawyer now lives and the following
Negroes (Slaves) Maria, Anne, Sarah, Jacob, Peter, John,
Chas, Samuel, Mary, Ann, Peter, and Mary in case my said
grand daughter dies leaving no issue of her body my Estate and
mine is that the aforementioned property should be my grand
daughter Jane Jane Sawyer. Now Give & bequeath to my
grand daughter Jane Jane Sawyer the land of 100 Acres
whereon I now live lying on the North side of Kings River
also the other half of my Estate or said Estate and the following
Negroes (Slaves) Maria, Anne, Sarah, Peter, John, Chas, Anne,
Mary, Jacob, Thomas, William, Matthew, Sarah, Anne & her heirs
in case my grand daughter Matthew in this clause dies leaving
no issue of her body then the property mentioned in this clause
shall be divided to my grand daughter Elizabeth Sawyer, to be
paid with my grand daughter Elizabeth Sawyer and Jane Jane Sawyer
should die without issue of their bodies then the property of said
Matthew to be divided as follows, to my land to be sold and the
following Negroes 1. to be sold also Charles, Peter, Anne, Peter,
Thomas, Anthony, Jacob, Mary, Peter, Anne, Sarah, Anne, Anne, Anne,
Thomas, Anne, Sarah, Peter, with their increase and the whole
amount of said Estate to be equally divided among the following
persons. The Wives of Henry Sawyer and of Robert Matthews, of
Mary Matthews, and of John Sawyer (deceased) and the following
Negroes Jane Matthews, Anne, Mary, Samuel, Mary, Peter, Anne,
and Anne with their increase to be equally divided between
the Wives of Thomas Matthews, between my grand daughter Jane
Sawyer Give & bequeath to my Anne Jane Matthews one half
and from thence two hundred Dollars to be paid by
my Executor after I have sold my property and a bill of sale
