

he bequeath to the first station also one Negro Boy by the name of Peter to him and his heirs forever, also two hundred and seventy two acres of Land known by the name of the Sandy pond also three Negroes to wit, Moke, Lucy and old Barks and their increase after the death or marriage of his father to him and his heirs forever, also one bed and furniture, two chairs and one two gallon Jug after the death or marriage of his mother to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand son Charles Adam five shillings specie to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand son Nathaniel Adam one Negro Girl named Phillis and her increase to him and his heirs forever after the death or marriage of his Grand Mother.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand son David Parker one hundred acres of Land known by the name of the Faneuil dog to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Stephenson one Negro girl called young Phill to her and her heirs forever.

Item I send Nathaniel Jones Negro girl Call with her increase unto my Daughter Charity Parker during her natural life, and after her death the Negro girl and her increase to be equally divided among my said Daughter Children, my will and desire is that the said Negro and her increase to be divided by the judgment of good men to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand son Isaac Rich two Acres and Colons to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath all that part of my estate that I have lent unto my beloved wife that I have not already given away unto my two Daughters Charity and Mary, and my grandson David Parker, and my grand son Isaac Rich to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever, also one Note of hand of John Furbath in case my wife shall not make use of the same in her life time to be equally divided between them as aforesaid to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand son Nathaniel Barker five shillings specie to him and his heirs forever.

Item My Will and desire is that if my Grand son Isaac Rich should die before he come to the age of twenty one years that all that part of my estate that I have given unto him, shall descend unto my Daughters and my Grand son David Parker to be equally divided between them their heirs forever as aforesaid.

And I constitute appoint and ordain my son Nathaniel Jenkins and my son Benjamin Jenkins my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament disannulling and revoking all other wills by me heretofore made to wit my Will and Testament dated the 15th day of September 1793.
