Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Wife Elizabeth Word One maple Desk, three walnut chairs, one Oak Table, of walnut, One half of my Kitchen furniture and one Yoke of Oxen to her and her heirs forever.

Item In my will and devise that all the residue of my estate not before given away should be sold by my Executor and pay all my just debts, should then remain a balance after my debts is paid, etc my will and devise that it should be equally divided between my wife and Children.

I do nominate and appoint Jonas Word, John Richard Executor and my wife Elizabeth Word Executrix of this my last will and Testament, revoking and disannulling all other Wills, and as other to be taken for my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this seventh day of May 1796.

James Warr's Will

In the name of God Amen I James Warr of Northampton County and State of North Carolina being weak in body but in my perfect sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament and give I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the dust from whence it came to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my executor, and as touching my worldly estate wherewith the Lord has blessed me with I give, devise and dispose of in the following manner Will.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Samuel Warr One third part of all my Land to him and his heirs and my Negroes known by the names of Adam, Nancy, his wife John Child Mary, Sherry and Isham and all the increase hereafter, and the Bay Killy which he rides (and the Horse which is called Stephen's Steer, if he goes to live for himself by the 25th December next and if not the Steer to go with the rest of my estate) likewise give him twenty barrels of Corn if there is as much left after the Eggs is sold if he goes to himself & if not to remain in the estate and I give him One thousand weight of Pork.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Milley Warr One third part of all my Land to her and her heirs and Negroes Scandal Warr and Isham which I brought of Brackin and One feather bed and furniture to be kept in good order by the estate until she comes of age and One hundred pounds Virginia currency if there is profusely enough to raise it and if not Samuel Warr to make the deficiency up and I give her my Buffot to her and her heirs.

Item I leave unto my beloved wife Milley Warr One third part of all my Lands and at her death to be equally divided between my Son Samuel Warr and my Daughter Milley Warr I give her my Negroes Becken and Rur, and the Bay Horse which was brought of John Clark and I give her four Score & Colons of her Cows and One feather bed and furniture and twenty barrels of Corn if there is as much after the Eggs is sold and I give her One thousand weight of Pork.

Was my will and desire that Lemuel Hays should keep William Harris two smallest Negroes and support them for the term of two years on his own expense

And my Will and desire is that the rest of my estate should be sold and after my just debts is paid to be equally divided between my Son Lemuel Hays and my Daughter Abby Hays.

And I do hereby nominate and appoint my Son Lemuel Hays Isaac Parker and William Hays my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills, devises Legacies and bequests ratifying and confirming this to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and fixed my Seal this 15th day of May 1796

Narmaduke Norfolk's Will

In the name of God amen I Narmaduke Norfolk of the County of North Carolina and County of Northampton being upwards of seventy five years of age and being in perfect sound mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of all mankind am willing to settle all my temporal affairs my sincere prayer is to be brought to rest in my last after death and that my body may be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the discretion of my executors whom I shall hereafter appoint my just debts being first paid I hereby ratify and I do dispose of the remainder of my estate in form and manner as follows

Imprimis I give and bequeath to my son Ruben Norfolk several parcels of land and tenements lying on the North side of Roanoke river and joining each other and lying in both Northampton County & Currituck County being the lands which I bought of James Williams Benjamin Foreman & Ruben Norfolk & Edward & John Williams likewise the lands on the South side of Roanoke river that I have already made over to my son Ruben Norfolk by a deed of Gift I do acknowledge it to be a free gift, all the above mentioned Lands I give to my son Ruben and to his heirs forever, I likewise give to my son Ruben Norfolk a parcel of Negroes that he has had in possession for some time past that is to say one Negro man called Harry one negro man called Daniel, one negro man called Abraham one negro woman called Hagar, and all her children excepting one negro girl called Venus, likewise I give him one negro woman called Rose and all her children, I likewise I give him one negro man called Tony, likewise I give him one negro woman called old Harry I likewise give to my son Ruben Norfolk all my Stock of cattle and Hogs that is under the care of Mills Young and the work house & plough belonging to that plantation where Mills Young lives and a young mare called Dennis.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Judith Barker the land and plantation whereon Joshua Barker now lives on the east side of the highway near the Land that I bought of William Woundtree lying and being in Elizabeth County, Virg I give it to her and her heirs, but if she should die without an heir begetter of her body my will is that it should fall to my son
