

Thomas Westbrooks Will

In the name of God Amen I Thomas Westbrook of Northampton County in the State of North Carolina being sick and a bed body but of sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God for calling me to meet this moment of my body and knowing it is appointed for all men to die Do make and ordain this my last will and Testament principally and first of all bewaring my soul into the hands of Almighty God my body to the ground to decently buried at the discretion of my Executors and my worldly goods give and dispose of in the form hereunder following -

Item Give and bequeath to my son John Westbrook the Land & plantation whereon now lies after my wife deceased to him and his heirs forever if he dies without issue lawfully begotten of his body give the said Land and plantation whereon now lies to my son James Westbrook to him and his heirs forever reserving the use of my Land & plantation to my wife during her natural life.

Item Give to my son John Westbrook two Cows, one leather box Furniture also one Chair & Chair to him and his heirs forever

Item I leave the use of all my estate which three children by intention to my beloved wife during her natural life after her death my will and desire is that all my estate should be equally divided between all my children except my Daughter Diana & the Sons of my Daughter Sabra to be to them and their Heirs forever.

I do hereby appoint Timothy Morgan and Robert Davis Sons and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament making all other Wills by me made certifying this and no other to be my last Will and Testament - In witness whereof I have accounted set my Hand and Seal this the 9th day of September 1793 -

Alles Collier's Will

In the name of God Amen I Alles Collier of Northampton County in North Carolina being of a sound mind and memory thank be to Almighty God for the same and having that it is appointed for all men to die I do this 18th day of May in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighty three make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form as follows first I command my soul to Almighty God hoping through the merits of my beloved Saviour Jesus Christ that he will receive safely to whom it and my body to the grave to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned and for what worldly estate it hath pleased God to bestow or bless me with in this life I dispose of in manner & form as follows

Item first I will that my debts be paid.

Item I do leave to my wife Savannah Collier my Land and plantations until her death or marriage.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Nancy Collier and her Generation which is called the said Nancy Collier

Item I do leave to my wife Savannah Collier five Negroes and their increase, Robt. Hollister, Betsy, Hardy & George until my son Jonathan Collier arrives to the age of twenty one years or my wife death or marriage with all the remainder part of my estate until her death or marriage or my son Jonathan Collier comes of age or that term of time.

Item My Will is at my wife Savannah Collier death or marriage or when my son Jonathan Collier comes to the age of twenty one years or that term of time for all those five Negroes and their increase and all the remainder part of my estate excepting my Land to be sold and the money equally divided between my wife if not married and my six children, Nancy Collier, Grace Collier, James Collier, Sarah Collier, Sam Collier & Jonathan Collier or their Heirs, but if my wife marry before my son Jonathan Collier comes to the age of twenty one years old my will is first to be equally divided between my six children just above named only if not for her to have an equal part with those six children.

Item My will is at my wife Savannah Collier death or marriage for my Land to be sold and the money to be equally divided between my three Sons Grace Collier, James Collier & Jonathan Collier and Lastly I do appoint and ordain Joshua Collier, William Hester, and William Brown my wife and sell Owners of this my Land
