 being sick and weak in Body but in perfect sense and disposing Memory
 of mine thoughts be to God for the same and willing to move that
 it is appointed for all Men once to Die as much and advise this my
 last Will and Testament in Manner and Form following. I suppose
 then I give to my Daughter Rebecca Johnson five Shillings to have and
 her heirs forever
 then I give to my son David Johnson five Shillings to have and his
 heirs forever
 then I give to my daughter Amy Pops five Shillings to
 have and her heirs forever
 then I give to my daughter Elizabeth Bay five Shillings
 My Will and desire is that the half of my Negro Estate
 Slaves and Sheep and Horses on half of the Remainder
 of my ~~Real Estate~~ property to be equally divided among
 my four Children Robert Johnson, Rebecca Johnson, Margaret
 Vinton, and Elizabeth Massey and the other half of the
 above mentioned property I leave to my beloved wife Amy
 Johnson during her life and after her decease that the
 Remainder of said property to be equally divided among
 my four Children as the aforementioned half
 of my Estate is my Will and desire; and I do hereby constitute
 and appoint my beloved son Barnata Johnson and
 Robert Johnson my whole and sole Executors and Guardians
 of this my last Will and Testament, in Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 8th day of October one thousand eight hundred and
 thirty four
 Signed, Sealed, Proven and Delivered in presence of
 Washington Thompson, Northampton County N. C. June 2nd 1894.

 Barnata & Robert Johnson the Executors
