 Sells Rebecca her Sells her house and Cattle she gave to
 Sells to her Bed and Furniture Two Walnut Tables one side
 Board one Dress Two looking Glasses one set of Chaises one
 Barrel of Brand the several Hoes and riding Chair &
 Harness he has and her being furnished
 Also give her the one third part of my Land during her
 Natural Life
 I give my Lands to be Equally divided between my three sons
 at the decease of them when the first comes of Age Edmund
 Wood James Wood David Wood and in case the child
 that or Born should be a son to come equal with the
 others and in case a daughter be she share with the
 other daughters only to them and their heirs forever
 I give all the rest of my Negroes not before given away to
 be equally divided among all my Children Male & Female
