In the name of God Amen I being heavily of the Scurvy of Northampton and state of North Carolina being weak & knowing that it is appointed for all human once to die do make & ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, to wit: I give and bequeath unto my two daughters namely Polly W. Thompson and Rebecca Connolly my land and plantation which I now occupy and possess to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever. I then I give and bequeath to my two daughters above mentioned each of them one feather bed of furniture to them and their heirs forever.

I then I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly W. Thompson two pine chests to her and her heirs forever. I then I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Connolly one black walnut chest to her and her heirs forever. I then I give and bequeath unto my daughter Polly W. Thompson my loom and gear to her and her heirs forever.

I then I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly W. Thompson one spinning wheel one pair of pins, two sitting chairs, one pot and books, one skillet one large Quarter dish one basin and one pewter plate, to her and her heirs forever. I then I give bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Connolly one Table two sitting chairs, one pot & books one dutch oven, one small Roaster dish, one basin and one

~~piece of furniture~~ I give to my two daughters namely Polly and Rebecca Connolly one cow and six pigs for their support. I therefore constitute and appoint Turner Dwyer my only executor to this my last Will & Testament reciting all other wills made by me this 12th day of April 1814

Jeremiah Daughtry's Will. In the name of God Amen I Jeremiah Daughtry of Northampton County North Carolina being weak in body but of disposing mind and memory, thanks be to Almighty God for the same and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all flesh once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows (to wit) first I recommend my soul in the hands of Almighty God that gave it relying on the meritorious blood of my Saviour to have full remission of all my sins: and as to what worldly estate it hath pleased God to bless me with I depose of in the following manner vizt. I then I lend unto my beloved wife Lucy Daughtry during her natural life a part of the lands and plantation whereon I now live (to wit) beginning at Charles Edmunds's corner in the mouth of the ready Marsh, thence up the ready Swamp to Matthias Williamsons corner thence Williamsons line to the down line, thence the down line to the ready Marsh thence down the Marsh to the first Station.

I then I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Lucy Daughtry four negroes (to wit) Etheldred, Belah, Lydda and Henry also my worst horse my riding ciner and mule, one feather bed, and furniture, two cows and calves to her and her heirs forever.

I then I lend unto my beloved wife Lucy Daughtry three negroes by the name of Sam, Jimmy and Ben during her natural life or widowhood.

I then I give unto my daughter Martha Daughtry three hundred and twenty acres of land it being the land I purchased of Howell Edmunds Junior or his dead, and I also give unto her two negroes by the name of Simon and Beck, my Bay horse, my single chair and harness and one feather Bed and furniture, to her the said Martha Daughtry and her heirs forever.

I then My will and desire is that the residue of my stock and perishable estate should be sold to discharge my just debts, and the balance arising from such sale to be equally divided among the residue of my children namely Mary Daughtry, Nancy Daughtry, Emily Daughtry, Lucy Daughtry and my young son child that my wife is pregnant with at this time.
