I Nancy Crowder of Nathampton County State North Carolina
being very poorly and weakly in body but of sound mind
and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and
Testament in manner and from following vizt -

I then I give to my daughter Sarah true and daughter Patsy
Crowder three head of cattle six head of hogs one spinning
wheel one pair cotton cards one pair flat Iron one pot one oven
one skillet three setting chairs one black walnut chest
two pine tables all the earthen ware one leather trunk one
plow hoe one grubbing hoe two weeding hoes one head bowl
one meal sieve one sash one powdering tub two gurns one
three gallon jug one half gallon jug one coffee pot one half
dozen spoons one washing tub one water pail one pewter plate
three slays one Corn hide to be sold and the money arising
from such sale after paying all my just debts to be equally
divided between my two children above named to them and
their heirs and assigns forever. I also nominate & appoint
Jonathan Cress and William Harding executors of this my
last Will & Testament in writing whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 8th day of
