Will of John Vaughan

In the name of God Amen, I John Vaughan
of the County of Northampton & State of North Carolina
do declare the following to be my last will and
Testament: I give and bequeath unto my son Richard Vaughan all
the land whereon I now live, lying below the following
line beginning at the main vein of Wheeler
Mill running where a new bottom empties into
the said stream, which said bottom commences where
the mill path crosses the road, leading from this
to Northampton County House, then a straight
line to a corner gum in my new line, then a
continuance of the same course until it intersects
the new road, then along the new road until it
intersects Norman Branch, and including the
mill and its appurtenances, including also
a tract of land lying in Jamesville County, Virginia
which the said Richard has now in possession and
which he formerly held also the tract of land
purchased of James Mynum: the before mentioned
tracts of land I give unto my said son Richard
his heirs and assigns forever. I also give and bequeath
unto my son Richard the following Negro slaves
Wm. Blanton, George, Thos, Alfred, Cherry, Dan,
Frank, Men, Peter, Laot, Sarah, Nancy, her Mary
her children (which said Nancy & children he has
had some time in possession & enjoy together with
all their future increase to him his heirs and
assigns forever.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah McWhorter all
annuities during her life, twenty five dollars which my said
son Richard is to pay and lay out in such manner as
he thinks most proper & thereby charge the legacies which
I have given to the said Richard with the aforesaid legacies
to my daughter Sarah.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Mann
the following Negro slaves (Wm. Gentry, Lucy, her Mary,
Nancy, her Mary, John, Dick a son of Lucy, Dick & Mary)
also the children (which said Dick and Mary & her children she
has had some time in possession) together with all their
future increase, & also the sum of one thousand dollars
to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my son Charles Vaughan the
tract of land whereon he now lives, the tract of land
acquiring which I purchased of Thomas Barrett & my
tract of land lying in Smith County, the aforesaid
tracts of land to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I also give and bequeath unto my said son Charles
the following Negro slaves (Wm. Gentry, which said
that he has had sometime in possession) Stephen, London,
Tins, which Harry, Man, John, John, & Chancy, & their
future increase, also one thousand five hundred dollars
to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my son James Vaughan all my
land above the line as laid down in the devise made by
son Richard Vaughan, including the land I bought
of John McWhorter for a part of the land I purchased
of Goul. Allen Jones & bounded by the line of Norman
Branch & other: also a tract of land on Clinton
Creek, on which the said James formerly lived, the
aforesaid tracts of land to him his heirs and assigns
forever. I also give & bequeath unto my said son
James the following Negro slaves (Wm. Gentry, Francis,
Patty, John & her children (Wm. Henry, Laot,
& Matthew), Peter which Peter he has now in
possession) Sam, Ray, & her children (Wm. Gentry,
& Peter) Lucy, John & Nelson & their future
also one thousand five hundred dollars.

and assigns forever.

Item Give and bequeth to my daughter Penelope Cammons the following negro slaves Thos Harvey 1 brock and their children, which negroes shall & their children she has now in possession or are in the possession of her husband Meridian Cammons, Paul Sam Harry Will Art Levi Ellen Jesse John Patty and I be & their future increase to her her heirs & assigns forever —

Item Give and bequeth unto Mary Jones the quarters of the late William Jones the children Maria and Elizabeth wife of Joseph W. Pittsinger, Patty Ruth Jones & John Wells Jones, one hundred pounds Virginia money to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever —

Item After paying all my just debts and all such Legacies as are before mentioned in this Will, it is my Will and desire that my son Richard Crump & Penelope Cammons (my daughter) divide all the money that I now have on hand and all the debts due me due and have a like, which money shall be divided Equally & bequeth to them & there heirs forever —

Item Give and bequeth unto my daughter Sarah Whitehead two cows and a calves to her & her heirs forever —

Item Give & bequeth all the rest and residue of my Estate of what kind or nature soever to be equally divided between my children, Richard Crump Martha Mason, Charles Crump, James Crump, & my daughter Penelope Cammons to them & their heirs forever —

Item It is my Will and desire that there be no sale made of any part of my Estate in order to make a division among my children agreeable to my Will —

Lastly I constitute and appoint my son Richard Crump & my friend James Crum executor of this my last Will and Testament. In testimony whereof these presents set my hand and affix my seal this twenty first day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve —
