7th I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Hart one negro woman such and her increase hereafter to her & her heirs forever after the death or marriage of my wife.

8th I give and bequeath to my daughters Partheny and Demy Hart one negro woman Alex and her increase one bed and furniture to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever after the death or marriage of my wife.

9th I constitute and appoint my son John Hart my whole and sole executor to this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, legacies, bequests and executors by me in any way before named ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will & Testament - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day & date first above written.

This last Will and Testament of Warren Hart son Test. was proved in open Court by the oath of Danny Phillips whereupon John Hart the executor in the said will named was qualified according to law - ordered to be certified & recorded -

Robert Fox's Will.

In the name of God Amen. I Robert Fox a resident of North Carolina Northampton County being of sound and perfect mind and memory (Blessed be God) do this Friday fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say.

Item 1st I lend unto my beloved wife Jemima Fox one third part of the plantation whereon I now live during her natural life to be laid off in manner following. Beginning at the West end of my Tobacco ground at the road and running a North West direction so as to include the Mansion House and take the greatest proportion of the dower in the land purchased of General Allen Jones. I lend also unto my beloved wife one third part of my moiety of the Mill owned by James Mitchell and myself erected across the Beaver pond Creek during her Widowhood.

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Jemima Fox one feather bed and furniture, one horse, two Cows & Calves and one deer, all of first choice, also an equal proportion of my negroes with my children Maria, Sebastian, Theresa, and Mary Anna Fox, to her & her heirs forever.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my son Sebastian Fox all my land lying in Northampton County. Also my moiety of the mill erected across the Beaver pond Creek which is attached to said land and the timber belonging to me in James Mitchell's low grounds on said Creek together with two years schooling at such school as his guardian shall think proper to send him to which shall be paid out of my estate.

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my daughter Luitilda Fox Dampson one bed and furniture and ten dollars in cash to her and her heirs forever.

Item 5th I give and bequeath to my children Maria, Sebastian, Thirafa and Marianna Dox an equal proportion there and share alike of all my negroes after taking off my wife's proportion of the negroes and all of my other estate of whatsoever nature it shall be, after paying my just debts, to them and their heirs forever, and so soon as one or more of my children shall come of age or marry my will and desire is that a division of my negroes be made to them, and all other of my property wherein they share equal shall be made and the proportion of those coming of age or marrying shall be paid over to them and the balance to remain in common stock until some one of the others come of age or marry and so on until they all come of age or marry.

Item 6th My will and desire is that my executors shall sell my Prince George land lying in the State of Virginia also all my perishable estate except my negroes for the purpose of paying my debts, but if that be not sufficient my executors or the acting one of them may at their discretion sell such of my other property as he or they may think can be best spared.

Item 7th My will and desire is that in case my wife should be pregnant at the time of my death and the child or children when born be a man child or children that then and in that case the said child or children shall divide my land equally with my son Sebastian, and divide my other estate such as negroes and the sales of my perishable estate equally with my wife and children, but in case the child or children when born be a female child or children then and in that case the child or children shall divide equal share and share alike with my wife and children so far as relates to my perishable estate.

Item 8th

Item 8th My will and desire is that in case any of my children should die under age or without issue that my estate here in devised to them should be equally divided among my surviving children except my land which I shall descend equally to my surviving male children if any, otherwise to be equally divided among my female children.

Item 9th My will and desire is that my worthy friends Frances Dancy, Francis Will and James Mitchell be appointed special guardians to all my children to act in succession as they are herein named. They are hereby empowered to educate my children as they may think proper and to pay the expenses thereof out of the estate devised to them and buy and sell at all times such personal property as they may think proper for the benefit of said Orphans estates and for the purpose of making an equitable division between the heirs.

Item 10th I do hereby recommend my soul into the hands of its Creator and my body to be decently buried by my executors in a Masonic manner.

Item 11th I do hereby make and obtain my worthy friends - Francis Dancy and Daniel Mason executors of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I the said Robert Dox have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written.

I wish paid to James G. Harrison or a sufficiency to satisfy
the debt due from me to him - All balance of monies
arising from the sale of my estate and debts due me before
my death I wish equally divided among my wife Jamina
Fox and four children, Hannah Fox, Sebastian Fox, Theresa
Fox and Maximina Fox share and share alike

by the said Robert as a codicil to his last Will and

I Nancy Crowder of Nathampton County State North Carolina
being very poorly and weakly in body but of sound mind
and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and
Testament in manner and from following vizt -

I then I give to my daughter Sarah true and daughter Patsy
Crowder three head of cattle six head of hogs one spinning
wheel one pair cotton cards one pair flat Iron one pot one oven
one skillet three setting chairs one black walnut chest
two pine tables all the earthen ware one leather trunk one
plow hoe one grubbing hoe two weeding hoes one head bowl
one meal sieve one sash one powdering tub two gurns one
three gallon jug one half gallon jug one coffee pot one half
dozen spoons one washing tub one water pail one pewter plate
three slays one Corn hide to be sold and the money arising
from such sale after paying all my just debts to be equally
divided between my two children above named to them and
their heirs and assigns forever. I also nominate & appoint
