Persons, at their death, by his giving, there have and shall
be the same Wills of Sale to be made & of no Effect, a Master
Churchy makes & endues my young Langley Cranberry & Arthur
known Executors of this my last Will & Testament, in Witness whereof
I have said William Cranberry here to this my last Will & Testament
at my house & Seal the Day & Year above written
