I give and bequeath unto my two grand children Susan & Joseph Russell one fourth her and furniture one hour, & setting chairs & picture frames, & further plates and one dozen further pieces to be equally divided between them, but should we die before she arrives to lawful age the surviving one to inherit the whole of said legacy, to have and their heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Nancy Russell one bed cover not quilted to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my two grand daughters Mary and Martha Russell all my wearing apparel of every description, to be equally divided between them when and there alike, but should we die before she arrives to lawful age, the surviving one to inherit the whole of said legacy to have and their heirs forever. It is my will and desire that the above Legacies remain in the hands of my Executor hereafter to be named until my said Legacies shall arrive to lawful age to be kept or disposed of in that way I direct that he in his wisdom shall judge most advantageous to my said Legacies until they shall arrive to lawful age. Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my friend my friend Harrison Boyer the whole and sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament the day and date first above written.
