Susannah Gurns will. In the name of God Amen
I Susannah Gurns of Northampton County being of sound and perfect mind (blessed be God) at this 25th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven make and publish this my last Will and Testaments in manner following, that is to say. First. I give unto my Son Abraham Gurns one half of my negro man bats and one stock of hogs to him and his heirs forever. I give unto my son Nathan Gurns one dollar, 50c. I give unto my daughter Ruth Gurns one pound, one iron wheel one blue shirt and twenty dollars in money and one bushel peat of my father and brother's wood to her and her heirs forever my desire that she live one story there and all except of my land to live on as long as she lives single. I give unto my daughter Martha Gurns one bottle shad and four loaves the best day my brother is taught me we shall eat

the fourth part of my pasture and brother one & brother's son wife forever etc. I give unto my Daughter Deborah Room one third and one fourth of my pasture and brother's son wife to her and her heirs forever — 5th I give unto my Son Humphrey Jacobs all the land and plantation that was given to me by my late Husband in his last Will one half of my negro man bats all my stock of cattle and sheep, one mile, one pair of iron scalds and house Lot and Kitchen furniture and all the balance of my estate so already given away to him and his heirs forever — I hereby make & Ordain my Son Humphrey Jacobs the Executor of this my last Will and Testaments, In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal the day and date and above written.
