The Manuscript Will of George Hogg
dated the 5th 1807 - At the Court of the County of
George Hogg to the Matter that she was named George Hogg

Polly Hogg as follows - Mrs. Mabou to have one share of her

Thomas Dehanna's Will

Item I give unto Elizabeth Taylor my slave & her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto John Taylor or his heirs forever
to her & her heirs forever

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
