

Elizabeth the following land whereon I now live bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at the mouth of the ready Branch then up the said Branch to the Head then with my own Boundary to Matthew Johnsons Corner Black Iron Standing in the Horse Branch from thence a strait line to a large oak Standing on the road side near my Black Iron. Thence from thence nearly north course to the Head of a branch that runs up near the Road then down the said branch to the ordinary Branch down that to the old mill pond side then up the side of pond to the first plantation during her Natural life - Item. I give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth

Olson Negroes known by the following names, Dick, Phoebe, Honour, Easy, Henry, Jacob, Helen, Charity, Mary, Sarah, & Jack to her & her Heirs forever - Item. My Will and desire is that the plantation I bought of Matt Johnson should remain in the possession of my Executors also Eight Negroes known by the following names, Champen, Luke, Young Father, Ridley, Lucy, Harsh, daughter of Luke, Rachel & Betsy, the said Negroes to be worked on said plantation for the special purpose of maintaining my daughter Betty M. Newson and her family also all the stock, crops, household and kitchen furniture, plantation utensils to remain on said plantation for the purpose of carrying on the business, but in case her present Husband Willis Newson should die in her life time, then my will is that my Executors put her in full possession of all the property I have left in their possession for maintenance of a single wife simple to her and her Heirs forever, but in case my daughter Betty M. Newson should die in the life time of her present Husband Willis Newson, then I give the land and plantation whereon she now lives to her equally divided between my two grandsons James Olson and Thomas Newson to them and each of them and their Heirs forever, also my will is that all the personal estate remaining on the plantation aforementioned should be equally divided between my daughter Betty M. Newson's children then alive, in case of her death, these & their heirs to them and each of them and their Heirs forever.

Item. I give unto my son Oum Hall the remaining part of the tract of Land whereon I now live as I have not lent it my wife with all the improvements blacksmith tools, machinery &c to him and his Heirs forever - Item. I give unto my son Oum the following land lying on the bycrop Swamp bounded as follows Beginning at the mouth of the great Branch down the swamp to the Beaver dam Swamp then up the beaver dam to the mouth of the pine branch then up the pine branch to a corner to be made there a strait line to a large line leaving about two hundred yards of the wood Land to the Blackwell plantation all the way then with a raised line to the great Branch then down said branch to the first Station to him and his Heirs forever -

Item I give unto my son Oum Station Negroes known by the following names, Jake, Jerry, Ted, Harry, Harsh, Ben, Wice, Betty, Sarah, Cheskill, Stephen, Samp, Willis, old Jimmy, and Sena, & Anthony to him and his Heirs forever - Item. I give unto my son Henry all the remaining part of my land that lies over the beaver dam Swamp that I have not given to my son Oum to him and his Heirs forever -

Item. I give unto my son Henry Olson Negroes known by the following names, James, Ambrose, Hall, Peter, Lottice, Solomon, David, Mary daughter of Lottice, Adam, Percily, Phil, and old Father, to him and his Heirs forever - Item. I give unto my daughter Martha Maria ten Negroes known by the following names, Phoebe, Simon, Lewis, Carter, Sam, Mary, Esther, Abby, Selby and Abner to her and her Heirs forever - Item. I give unto my grand daughter Harriett Newson one Negro boy named David son of Peter to her & her Heirs forever - Item. I give unto my daughter Betty M. Newson next child that should be born after the date of this my Will one Negro girl by the name of Angelina to her and her Heirs forever - Item. I give unto my grandson James O. Newson one Negro boy by the name of Doctor to him and his Heirs forever -

Item. I give unto my grandson Thomas O. Holloman one Negro boy by the name of Laurence to him and his Heirs forever - Item. My Will and desire is that all the

Of my Negroes that should come after the date of this my Will should go with their Masters as they are devised to each of them and their heirs forever. Item I give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth my ffig, and threescore three work Horses, four Cows and Calves four Swine & ffigs, two feather beds and Furniture, my Chaise, and all my other bookcase, ware, and fifty Barrels of Grain and two thousand weight of pease to her and her heirs forever. Item I send unto my beloved wife Elizabeth one Watch and look case two tables two Chaires dressing, her natural life, and after her death I give the Watch and look case and tables to my daughter Martha Maria, to her and her heirs forever. Item I give unto my son James three Horses say three Redd Horses, two & half mare, four Cows & Calves four Swine and ffigs, and two feather beds & Furniture, two tables one bedd Chaire and all other household & kitchen furniture and plantation utensils that he is now in possession of, also one Land compass Surveying Instruments to him and his heirs forever. Item I give unto my son Henry three Horses four Cows & Calves four Swine and ffigs two feather beds & Furniture, two tables one bedd fifty Barrels of Grain and two thousand weight of pease, also after the death of my wife I give him the Chaire that I sent her to him and his heirs forever. Item I give unto my daughter Martha Maria two feather beds and Furniture to her and her heirs forever.

My Will and Desire is after the death of my wife that the said land that she should be equally divided the number of acres and the part the Houses is and I give to my son Henry to him and his heirs forever. Item I give the other parts of my land after the death of my wife to my daughter Martha Maria to her & her heirs forever.

There is six Negroes that I have not given away, if my Will can be discharged without selling of them, though my will is that they be divided as I shall hereafter direct. Item my Will & Desire is that all my Estate that I have not given away or lent should be sold by my Executors & Administrators arising to

discharge all my last debts and after all paid, if any remaining with the six Negroes above named to be equally divided between my wife Elizabeth and my pleasing Children, Thomas D. Cannon, Henry & Martha Maria Hollamons to them and each of them & their heirs forever. And I do hereby nominate and appoint my dear son Thomas D. & Cannon Hollamons my sole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament discharging all other this to be my Will whereby I shall hereunto affix my Hand and Seal this 27th day of June 1808 & twenty signed, sealed in the presence of } *Chas Hollamon* *Car*

This last Will & Testament of James Hollamons last read and exhibited in open Court and duly proved in the following manner (Viz) The whole of the said Will and the signature thereof proved to be in the hand writing of the Testator, by John Pugh, John M. Bassett, Allan Holway and John Whelan the said will was found in the Testators Desk among his valuable papers & Effects proved by the Oaths of Robert Stewart & Joseph P. Rogers, whereupon James Hollamons Clerk one of the Executors in said Will named was qualified as the Law directs, to be certified and Recorded.
