

gear and pair of Horses also one half of my plantation utensils at both places also the use of the tract of Land whereon I now live during her natural life then to return to my daughter Mary A W Pennell also I bequeath her part named above except my land to her and her heirs forever also three feather beds and furniture and the window Curtains belonging to the house one clock also my earthen ware glass and China ware & kitchen furniture together with the side board and press one half my Stock not otherwise devised hereafter. God I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Ann Elizabeth Franklin Pennell my plantation in Guendville County on Mountain Creek containing 850 acres more or less to her and her heirs forever provided my daughter live to be married and has any lawful heirs also after the death of my beloved wife 850 acres more or less of Northampton County of No Carolina being the plantation where I now live also one half of my Stock of all kinds not heretofore disposed of my gig and harness and my horse named Stangle &c he also the following negroes Tany Chany Alfred Neal Sharr her Brisk Luisa Harwell Green Jude Edmund Adam Austin Old Tom Elly Allen Kinchen Pleasant Martha Little Ben Charlotte Beck Priscilla Little Brisk and old bet one feather bed and furniture one Desk and book case one Walnut Dressing Table one large looking glass belonging to it one large blue Chest with Drawers and one large Walnut armed Chair formerly my fathers As the I will and desire that the balance of money that may be due me or my estate together with all other property ^{not signed} after the payment of my debts be equally divided between my wife and my daughter. And whereas my brother William W Pennell is now indebted to me by bond my wish and will is that his bond be allotted in the division of the money to my daughter Mary A & W Pennell and that

my said Bro: William W Pennell be not compelled to pay it until he arrives to full age or married. 5th I will and bequeath to my old negro man Dick his full freedom also I will that so long as Dick the above freed negro attends to the plantation heretofore given to my daughter and does the duty of an owner that he shall have the amt of \$50⁰⁰ per annum. Item I give unto Robert Kice my smooth barrel shot Gun to him and his heirs forever. Item 6th In case my daughter Mary A & W Pennell should die before she arrives to lawful or married I shall lawful heirs of her body I will and desire that all the property I received by my former wife Elizabeth Jordan should return to the Jordan family and all the other property will be to my said daughter Mary A & W Pennell be equally divided between my three brothers to wit John Pennell Benjamin Pennell and William W Pennell or their heirs Shaw and Shaw alikes. Item I give to my beloved wife Mary A Pennell the bond due me from Elizabeth Wynnem to her and her heirs forever. Item 7th I give to my brother William W Pennell all my wearing apparel. Item lastly I do nominate and appoint my brother William W Pennell and my brother in law Thomas Wynnem Executors to this my last will and Testament given under my hand and seals this day and date first above written hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

This last will and Testament of Joseph Pennell decd was exhibited to this Court & proved in due form of Law by the Oaths of Edwin H Pate one of the Subscribing witnesses thereto the Executors in said will named refused to qualify as such. Whereupon Administration with the will the will annexed
