give & bequeath & bequeath unto Petty, 13th of New-Hampshire - New-  
Hampshire, one hundred Dollars to her & her heirs forever

give & bequeath unto Esther Green of the State of Vermont  
one hundred Dollars to her & her heirs forever

give & bequeath unto Harriet Petty of New-Hampshire, State of N.H.  
one hundred Dollars to her & her heirs forever

give & bequeath unto Lydia Cresswell of New-Hampshire, State of N.H.

support them in their declining Years, & to pay their debts if they  
are any so third & their heirs forever

Lastly make & ordain my worthy Friend Richard McElroy Esq.  
Executor of this my last Will & Testament - in witness whereof I have
