In the name of God Amen. I Joseph Bridgers of Northampton County being neither Rody, but of perfect sound mind & Memory thank God to the Almighty God for the same and as touching such Temporal Estate as I have given to be settled on me, I give and dispose of in manner & form following.

First I bequeath to my Grand Son Joseph Bridgers all the increase of pitch on my plantation, since he came to live with me, also

The crop of all Kinds, Lending & Lekin Heirs & Spouse forever.

Also hereby appoint my Son Nathan Bridgers, while I live.

Executor of this my last Will & Testament, or Whichever whereof shall

happen a first by hand & first my Seal the 13th Day of October 1803

In the name of God Amen, I James Roberts of the County

of Northampton, North Carolina being over & past of Eighty

Year of sound Mind & Memory do make & ordain this

my last Will & Testament, on the following manner, to wit:

That part of my Will is that all my just debts shall be

paid first.

My Will is that my Grandson Miller West should have

in Red & Burntine, on West, on Bay Staff on graving

Bay, on Harbor off & to him his Heirs & Friends.

My Will is that Jonathan Roberts, William Roberts &

Mary West should have ten Shillings of my Estate each

of them, to them their Heirs & Friends.

My Will is that Alexander Roberts should have all the

Residue of my personal Estate of whatever Nature, or

Value, when his Heirs & Friends.

My Will is that my Land Division from his wife shall be equally divided between my Sons, James Roberts & Robert, containing the same land & strictly fair share, to the same men or less, to them, than their Heirs & Friends.

My Will is that dear Alexander Roberts, my Son should maintain their Mother, Anne Roberts during her Natural life.

Lastly, My Will & Wish is that Jonathan Roberts & Alexander Roberts should be Executors of this my last Will & Testament, making all other Will or Wills hitherto made, & written, void of & have no more

Effect than & that this 3rd day of March 1803.
