Item Give and bequeth unto Mary Jones the sum of the late William Jones her husband, Maria and Little John wife of Ralph W. Littlejohn, Patsy Burke Jones & Mary Wade Jones, one hundred pounds Virginia money to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever —

Item After paying all my just debts and all such Legacies as are before mentioned in this Will, it is my Will and desire that my son Richard Crump & Penelope Camonds (my daughter) divide all the money that I may have on hand and all the debts due me due and stand a like, which money shall be divided Give & bequeth to them & their heirs forever —

Item Give and bequeth unto my daughter Sarah Whitehead two cows and calves to her & her heirs forever —

Item I Give & bequeth all the rest and residue of my Estate of what kind or nature soever to be equally divided between my children, Richard Crump, Martha Mason, Charles Crump, James Crump, & my daughter, Penelope Camonds to them & their heirs forever —

Item It is my Will and desire that there be no sale made of any part of my Estate in order to make a division among my children agreeable to my Will —

Lastly I do make and appoint my son Richard Crump & my friend James Crum executor of this my last Will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty first day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve
