

# Autumnative Will of Dolly Webb

Autumnative Will made by Dolly Webb on the Twentythird day of June 1809. as follows. First I desire that all my best debts should be paid out of my Estate. Second I give unto Phyllis Webb Elizabeths daughter one Bed and one chest which was my Mothers and furniture that belong to her I desire that Phyllis should give quiet to Dolly Webb as many of my blood as will satisfy her for her attendance on me in my last illness.

I give unto Phyllis Chapman all and every Part of my property that is not before mentioned to him and his heirs forever and Matrimony hands and Deeds this Twentythird day of June 1809.

## Eliza Leesters Will

In the Name of God Amen, I Eliza Lester of Northampton County and State of North Carolina Being weak in my Body but in my perfect reason and Memory, Knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die: do make and declare this my last Will & Testament, And first I commend my Soul unto the hands of almighty God who gave it; then my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors and for my Whole Estate which the Lord hath blessed me with, I give and dispose of in the following manner And first I Give I Leave unto my beloved Wife Sally Lester all my Lands and Plantations which I possess during her natural Life or Widowhood to raise and maintain my Children I further say Will and desire is that all my Negroes and also my other Estate be kept together until my Son Ninchen Lester

arrive to the Age of 21 Years or marry's after the expiration of which time, my Will and Desire is that my Lands may be equally Divided between Ninchen Lester and Henry Lester my two Sons.

I leave unto my beloved Wife Sally Lester during her natural Life four Negroes, named as follows, Will, Hannah, Mary, & Dido, and then after her decease to be equally divided between all my Children, namely, Ninchen Lester, Henry Lester, Dorothy Lester, Nancy Lester, Robert Lester, & Mary Lester.

My Will and Desire is further that after my Son Ninchen Lester arrives to the Age of 21 Years that all my Negroes and the income and profits and likewise my other Estate not above named, be and is equally Divided between all my Children above mentioned. And in my Will and Intent for my Negroes and property as is above mentioned to be kept on my Lands until my Son Ninchen Lester arrives to the age above mentioned, a Mary's is that my Family be kept together and maintained in the same, and my Children to have a liberal Education for the use of the same, and if there should not be an sufficient sum of money to settle my just Debts, I desire that one of my Sons be sold to settle the same. And I do hereby constitute and appoint Giles Lester, Eamon Holloman, and John Worth as my whole and Soul Executors to this my last Will and Testament, and hereby dissolve Revokes, and disannul all and every other former Will, Legacies and Bequests, Ratifying and Confirming this to be my last Will & Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and face my Seal this 8th day of October 1809. in the Presence of us — Northampton County, I Do hereby certify that this Will was proved by James Maynard, William Doughty, & John Smith at the same time Giles Lester qualified Executor. And was by us witnessed and Recorded. —
