I John Boykin being in a low state of health but thanks be to Almighty God in perfect mind & memory do make this my last will & Testament in and form following to wit. I give and bequeath unto my wife Catharine Boykin the following negro woman known by the name of Maria, Charlotte also five hundred pounds of bacon Two large winter Chins One horse One brown fifty barrels of corn, one thousand pounds of fodder, two large dining tables of Cherry or Maple, two beds & bed stiches, I also give to my wife Catharine Boykin, Twenty Dollars for the purpose of purchasing such kitchen furniture as she may stand in need of the above named property. I give and bequeath unto my wife Catharine Boykin and her heirs forever in fee simple. It is my will and desire that after selling a part such proportionable parts of my estate as will apiece my wife, that the balance or remaining part,

of my estate both real & personal goods and chattels of all kinds shall be sold the sale of my estate I leave it discretionary with my trustee and further consideration archy my trust will be most likely to insure the value of my estate \$10,000 It is my will and desire that of the sum of my trust debt in Paris that one thousand dollars shall be set apart for the education of my son Simon Davis Boykin \$1,000 It is also my will and desire that the then remaining part of my estate shall be equally divided between my daughter Eliza May Harrison my son William Henry Boykin my son John Pittman Boykin my son George Robert Boykin and my said Simon Davis Boykin the above mentioned part of my estate I give and bequeath to said Henry Harrison or daughter William H. Boykin John P. Boykin George R. Boykin and my son Simon J. Boykin unto them and their posterity in fee simple. I also do hereby nominate my son John P. Boykin William H. Harrison of Southampton County Virginia and James Rich of Roanoke County of Mississippi my hole and substance in this my last will and Testament about I have bequeathed set my hand and affix my seal this the tenth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty six
