James Davis Will

In the name of god amen I James Davis of Northampton County & State of North Carolina do make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form as followeth to wit, Item 1st. I leave to my beloved wife Sarah Davis the plantation whereon I now live with all the land on the South & west side of Lounds Branch with my Cotton gin for her Benefit & the benefit of my five daughters namely Elizabeth Davis Martha W Davis Sally K Davis Mary A Davis & Rebekah Ann Lucy Davis and at the death of my wife I give all the land unto her to my four daughters as before named with the Cotton gin as long as they live single & at the death or marriage of the last to be equally divided between the survivors to them & the heirs of their own body & issue & land to my wife three negroes namely Peter Carter & one with their increase during her natural life also two work horses four Cows & Calves two sows & pigs all my stock of Sheep geese &c and the plantations houses all the house and kitchen furniture desiring my wife to give to all our children one for her kids furniture when ever they may call for them I also land to my wife one string Waggon one little gig as she may choose during her life I give to my wife daughters if they stay together one years provision out of my estate & at the death of my wife all the land property except the succeed lands to be sold and distributed made as here after.

Item 2nd I have given to my son John P Davis one horse Longgale Item 3rd I have given to my son Thos P Davis one horse cold blooded Item 4th I have given to my son W G Davis one horse cold Easter Item 5th I give to my son Lepe H Davis one horse with colors Item 6th I give to my son Edwin C Davis one fifty cold Maleda Item 7th I give to my son Richard H Davis fifty dollars in the sum of a horse which money is to be raised out of my Estate when he comes of age

Item 8th I give to my son Thomas P Davis the tract of Land lying on the north side of Stock swamp known by name of graveyard field or the land sold by John M Donford to Hugh Weston adjoining the lands of Thomas J Southall Sam'l Daniel & the land I purchased of John Weston from him the said Thos P Davis his heirs forever

Item 9th I give to my son Edwin C Davis all the residue of my land on the North side of Stock swamp adjoining the land given to Thomas P Davis Sam'l Daniel & John H Patterson to him & his heirs forever

Item 10th I give to my son Thos P Davis Lepe H Davis & Richard H Davis all the land on the east side of Lounds Branch to be divided in equal quarterly between them value by themselves as they may choose so that they may receive money so as to equal the value Item 11th my will and desire is that all the property not left over given may be sold & the money after paying my debts to be divided amongst all my children as before named in this writing Item 12th My will and desire is all the property left to my wife I will give away at the death of my wife should be sold and divided out to twelve equal parts two of them parts to go to my sons John H Davis & the other ten parts to be divided into twelve parts and one twentieth begins to Thomas P Davis & the other twentieth given to W G Davis as his portion of my Estate & the balance equally divided among the rest of my children namely Elizabeth & Sally K Davis & Mary A Davis & Rebekah Ann Lucy Davis & others & there are fewer Item 13th if my above named daughters shall die without issue the surviving sister is to divide if they all die without heir as before stated it is to return to all the survivors & their heirs I do hereby nominate Thos P Davis my whole sole executor to this my last will & testament in witness my hand seal being the day of November one thousand eight hundred & thirty five —
