In the name of god Amen I William Hart being in a low State of health but of disposing mind & memory do make and ordain this my Last will & Testament in manner and form following (I. K)

Item 1 In the first place I wish all my just debts to be paid
Item 2 After all my just debts are paid I Give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary L. Hart every Species of property which I am in possession of at my death to wit Lands negroes & every other Species of property which belongs unto me, to her & her heirs forever
Item 3 I constitute and appoint my Grand Son John Phillips Executor to this my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 15th of February eighteen hundred & thirty three

Hardy Cobb will When as it is appointed for man to die & I must die as well as them mine I hereby make and ordain the following writing to be my last will and Testament

Item 1 I give my soul to God from whom I received it, in hopes of a happy and glorious Resurrection of both body and soul at the great day of accounts when retributive justice will be awarded to every one according to what he may have done in this vain world whether just or unjust

Item 2 I give devise and bequeath unto my dear wife Hannah T. Cobb one third part of my Lands including my dwelling house & out houses, Garden and Orchard horses, Cattle, hogs, houn hold and Kitchen furniture negroes Julia Sell & Rachel with my crop or haul of every description whatsoever to be at her own will and disposal

Item 3 I give devise and bequeath unto my Grand son John Hardy Peller negro boy Abraham to him and his heirs forever

Item 4 I give unto my Grand Daughter Mary Eliza Peller my negro boy Simon Piter to her and her heirs forever

Item 5 I bequeath unto my dear wife Hannah T. Cobb my negro Aaron during her life

Item 6 All the residue and remainder of my estate whether real personal or mixed I give devise and bequeath unto Nancy T. Peller subject to the payment of all my just debts to her and to hold to her and her heirs and assigns forever
Item 7 I hereby nominate and appoint my son in Law Isaac Peller my whole and sole executor to this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and declaring all others by me heretofore made null and void

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal manual this 11th day of Decr 1833
