Lastly I nominate and appoint my Beloved Mother Mary Ann Jordan executrix of this my last Will & testament hereby revoking all other wills & Testaments by me heretofore made.

Solow Halls Will

State of North Carolina Northampton County

I Solow Hall of the County & State aforesaid being weak in body but of sound mind memory & considering the certainty of death & the uncertainty of this mortal life do make certain this my last will & testament in manner & form following.

1st My will & desire is that all my Land lying on the south side of Swaham Swamp be equally divided between my four sons Isaac Joseph Sifer & Joseph Hall so as to give each equal share of an acre each to have the land they now have and Joseph to have the lands I now live on and also the land in said Swamp on the north side to be equally divided between said four sons Joseph Sifer & Joseph giving it as above named to them & their heirs forever.

2nd I give unto my son Joseph Hall one Saddle Horse & one further Breast Furniture to him & his heirs forever.

3rd I give unto my daughter Sarah Hall one Hundred dollars to her & her heirs forever.

4th I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Puller seventy five dollars to her & her heirs forever.

5th I give unto my daughter Polly Hall one further Saddle & Furniture to her & her heirs forever.

6th My will & desire is that all the residue of my Estate not given away be sold & after paying my debts the balance to be equally divided between all my children to wit Isaac Hall Sarah Hall Solow Hall Joseph Hall Sifer Hall Polly Hall Elizabeth Puller & Joseph Hall to them & their heirs forever.

7th I last do nominate & appoint my friend Shadrach Grant my whole sole executor to this my last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal.
