 and at his death the said negro man I give to my daughter Susan P. Jones,
 I give unto my son William Jones Children one son James in my negro woman Mary
 and all of her Children
 I give unto my daughter Polly Carpenter one son James in my negro woman Mary

and all her Children and I leave unto my daughter Polly Carpenter one negro woman
 by the name of being serving her life and at her death I give the said negro woman
 young, I leave her to her daughter Mary Carpenter to have and have her forever
 I leave unto my son James Jones one negro boy by the name of Henry
 serving his life and at his death I give the said negro boy Henry to my grand-
 daughter Mary Carpenter,
 I leave unto my son James Jones one negro man by the name of John serving his life
 and at his death the said negro man John, I give unto his daughter Mary Jones
 Jones to have and have forever
 I leave unto my daughter Polly Carpenter all of my house hold furniture with all
 Brass &c serving her life and at her death all the house hold furniture, I leave her
 to be taken and equally divided between my grand daughter Mary Carpenter and my
 grand daughter Susan Jones share and share alike
