In the name of God amen I Arthur Jordan of the County of Northampton and State of N.C. aforesaid living in advanced age and in the infirmity of bound health and mind rememb'ring that it is appointed for all men to die in the following manner despatch of my property and effects which it has pleased god to bless me with and to make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit.

Item It is my will and desire that my Executed hereunto appointed do out of the products of my present Crop and of the debts due me pay of all my just debts and of the same be not sufficient I desire the deficiency may be made up out of the money I have in possession.

Item I give to my beloved wife Nancy Jordan the following Slaves to wit Harry Lucy Ephraim &c. Jenny Sarah Caroline & Maria & Cate & Riley them and their increase to her and her heirs forever. Also lands my said wife during her natural life young Jenny 1797 Dick Emma Burwell Mary Sally & Anna and them and their increase, also the use of the plantation wherein I now reside, together with the Half of all my Stock of every description all my Dine hole and kitchen furniture and the half of my Crops and provisions to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to the heirs of my son John B. Jordan a. & the following Slaves to wit Jacob Allen Abraham Charly Patience Tom Black yellowish Addison Lucy Jenny Florida Mary Dick the Augy Phoebe Eliza Martha Margaret & Hannah and all the former increase of said Slaves in their possession to them and their heirs forever including all increase.

Item I give to my son Wilson B. Jordan all the Lands I am now signer and proprietor of on the south side of the Cuffee Swamp to wit the Lands I purchased of Mathew Johnson and all my interest in the Lands formerly Capt John Boykin and together with the tract he now resides on together with the following Slave Louis Bob Harrison Billy Mary Isaac Eliza Washington Amanda Hasty Prig Hardy Anna Matilda John Eliza & Sally them and their increase together with the lands aforesaid I give to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give to my grand daughter Mary A. M. Davis the following Slaves (now) Alfred Henry Cate Pleasant Allen Sharpe Brisk Louis Garwill Edmund Evans Tom Burwell Charly Etter Jude Albert Henry Mary aminda Cate Allen Christian George Almira Sham James Robert Augustus and Charlotte them and their increase to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my son James W. Jordan the following Slaves to wit Hal Hardy Ben Joe Nat Henry John Frank Charlotte Susan

Cherry Lucy Margaretha Jenny Silla Martha Mint Julia Morning Sarah Nancy and Daniel together with the tract of Land wherein I now reside at the death of my wife, also the slaves young Jenny 1797 Dick Emma Burwell Mary Sally & Anna and increase to my wife at her death, and further the one half of all my Stock Crops and provisions of every description & her the other James W. Jordan his heirs & forever.

Item I nominate constitute and appoint my beloved sons William and James W. Jordan Executors to this my last will and testament the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September one thousand Eight hundred and thirty seven.
