Whereupon Arthur Rogers one of the executors therein named qualified according to Law. None being presented for Celia W Barnes the other executor to qualify ordered that said will be certified recorded

JAMES D KELLY'S Will. In the name of god amen I James of a sound and perfect mind and memory I make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form as followeth. First I recommend my soul to god who giveth me in hope of a joyful recompence of the same and as to what worldly goods it hath pleased god to bestow on me I dispose of in mane and form as followeth to wish. As my debt and funeral charges being just paid. I bind unto my beloved wife Judith Kelly all my estate both real and personal during her widowhood or dies until my youngest child comes to the age of twelve years old and then my children to have the use of all the rewards except during & till Charles during of my wife's widowhood a life that the rewards all to come together and be equally divided at my wife's death or widowhood. I want my said wife and such of all kinds and to be equally divided between my children by my executors George Kelly and Charles Kelly. In witness whereof I have hereunto set

This paper writing purporting to be the last will and Testament of James D Kelly deceased was exhibited in open Court and proved in due form by the oaths of Richard H Martin John Castaphen & John Clark in the following manner to wit, that they believed the body of the said paper writing as well as the signature thereto to be in the proper hand writing of the aforesaid James D Kelly. Whereupon Charles D Kelly one of the executors therein named qualified according to Law. (the other Executor refused to qualify) ordered that the same be certified and recorded as the last will and testament of the said James D Kelly deceased - Clerk John W Harrison A.D.

In the name of god amen I Jones Grovers of the County of Southampton and state of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind and desiring memory to make of adam this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit I bind unto my beloved wife Judith Grovers all my total real and personal purchable for during her natural life except such property as I shall leave after deduction of legacies -

Item I give to my son William Grovers the following negroes to wife Anne and Eliza and all that heire and may increase from them -

Item I give to my son John Grovers one bed and furniture and two Negros Anthony and Gabriel to him and his heirs forever

Item I give unto my son Nathaniel Grovers the following Negroes Charles and Anna together with one bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Alexander Grovers one bed & furniture & the following negroes to wife one negro woman named Nancy two negro boys named Anderson & Cain, two negro girls named Cherry and Mary with all their future increase to him and his heirs forever -

After the death of my wife my wife and done is that all my estate both personal and moveable not specially given and bequeathed be equally divided between my grand daughter Mary Grovers, my grand son John Grovers Jr & my son John Grovers and Nathaniel Grovers & Alexander Grovers to share alike -

Lastly I nominate and appoint John Grovers and Alexander Grovers
