I Irwin Hill of the County of Northampton and State of N.C.
Being Weak in body but in perfect Mind and Memory do make and
Declare this my last will and testament in the following manner
First I Give and Bequeath to my son Lewis B Hill one Negro boy named
James &c I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Cephalina Hill
one Negro Girl named Harriet &c I Give and Bequeath to
my son Henry Hill one Negro Boy named Elie.

I Give to my wife beloved wife Nancy Hill one Negro Woman
named Mary and her increase my Stock of Land House
hold and Kitchen Furniture and Stock of all kinds During
her life I also Give my wife Nancy Liberty to Sell any part
of the above named Land property that she may think proper
to raise my Children to School them or to pay Just Debts
and at her Death to be Equally Divided between my three
Children above named My Will and wish is that Negro
Sannah and his wife should have the privilege of living on
my Land so long as they both live

I Leave Nancy Hill Executor to this my Last Will and
Testament Given under my hand and seal this the
27th of January 1831.

Josiah Outlands Will. Know all men by these presents
that I Josiah Outlands of the County of Northampton and State
of N.C. do constitute and appoint this my last will
and testament in manner and form following that is to say
First I give and Bequeath unto my son William Outlands the Land and
Plantation upon which he now lives also what property he has rec'd of
me and has in his possession to him and his heirs forever
Secondly I give and Bequeath unto my son John Outlands all the money
I have hitherto advanced to him in the purchase of his Land
also all the property he has of mine in his possession to him and
his heirs forever
Thirdly I give and Bequeath unto my son Exum Outlands the Land and
Plantation upon which he now lives including all the Land on the South side
of the Road which I purchased of James Colton also all the property
that he has of mine in his possession to him and his heirs forever
Fourthly I give and Bequeath unto my son Thomas Outlands the Land and
Plantation upon which he now lives also my will that the black man
Dick formerly let free by the Laws of Virginia should live thence
and her his support thereupon in case he should need it Also all
the property he has of mine in his possession to him and his heirs
in ever
Fifthly I give and Bequeath unto my before named sons William Outlands
John Outlands Exum Outlands and Thomas Outlands the sum of
Ten Dollars apiece to be paid them out of my Estate after my
death to them and their heirs forever
Sixthly I give and Bequeath unto my son in law Jonathan Copeland two certain
hides furniture now in his possession to him and his heirs forever
Seventhly I give and Bequeath unto my son in law David Copeland one certain
hide and furniture now in his possession to him and his heirs forever
Eighthly I give and Bequeath unto my Grandson William O. Copeland one feather bed
and furniture in his Father David Copelands possession also the sum of
Twenty dollars in money to be paid him when he becomes twenty one years of
age and in case he should die in minority to be equally divided among all
my heirs
Ninthly I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Rachel Howard one feather bed
and furniture to be delivered her as soon as may be convenient after
my death to her and her heirs forever
Tenthly I give and Bequeath unto my three Daughters namely Jane Howard Rachel Howard
Sarah Parker and my Grandson William O. Copeland all the rest and residue
of my Estate not given away be equally divided among them it is also my
Will that if my before named Grandson should die before he arrives to the
age of Twenty one year that part of my Estate allotted for him be equally divided
and amongst all my sons and daughters
Lastly I nominate and appoint my three sons William John & Exum Outlands
Executors to this my Last Will and Testament. In testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th day of the 12th month 1831.
