Elias Powell's Will In the Name of God Amen knowing that it is now
appointed for all men to die
I Elias Powell of Northampton County aforesaid mind and memory
do make this writing to containe my last Will and Testament revoking
all others made heretofore by me in manner and forme following
I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Holland Powell one Negro
man and Sallye Johnson Bob and Anna, two Leather Bids and furniture
one Horse named Broke and harned Nams Brunes two Cow and
Calves two Ewes and Lamb two Lambs and Pig & strong Chairs two spin-
ning wheels and two pair Chards the Room and all give two Chest two
Tables and all the kitchen Furniture and Farming Utenciles and the Cat
and Whels to her and her heirs forever also the Land wheran I now
live during her natural life or whileswoode
I give and bequeath unto my son Richard Powell one Negro man named
Baphraun and also my land after Death or marriage of my belovd
Wife Holland Powell to him and his heirs forever
I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elias Powell one
Negro girl named Eliza Feathr Bids and furniture one cow

and Calf to her and her Heirs forever
I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly Powell one Negro girl
Cherry one Leather Bid and Furniture one Cow and Calf to her and her Heirs forever
to my wife and dear is at my death after paying my Just debts that all the remaining
part of my negroes not given away and other Property be equally divided
among all my Children to witt Nancy Johnson, Fannie Davis, Ruthen
Powell, and Polly Powell together with their Heirs forever & including
my Daughter Fannie Davis two sons named Elias and William & a
and lastly I do nominate and appoint my son Kitchen Powell my
sole and sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament I do witness
gave him unto let my hand and seal this Twenty ninth day of
December one thousand eight hundred and thirty two

Elias Vicks Will In the name of God Amen I Elias Vicks
of the County of Northampton State of North Carolina being weak in Body
but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God omnipotent
mild the Master of my body and knowing that I am appointed for the men
to die to make and ordain this my last Will and Testament that
I may presentably and justly for all I have and command my soul into the
hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body to be buried in a decent
and Christian forme and as touching such worldly Estate wherewithal I am possessed
a god to keep in this life I give, devise, and despose of the same in the following
manner and forme

I give to my son James Vick the tract of land that he now possess belonging
to land adjoining the same bounded as follows beginning at a corner post where
a street line to Northamton line turns a street called to the rear of the Court then
at the crook to the corner of Shadwell land thence along said line to Amos Comer
including the exchequer of the land in one tract I give to my son James Vick one Bed &
furniture that he has possessed all one horse saddle and bridle that he has kept
from his birth in 1817 now
I give the balance of my lands to be equally divided between my two sons Robert
Vick and Henry Vick but my wife Eliza Vicks to have the privilege of one
third part thereof during her life

I give to my son Elias Vick one negro boy named Joshua also one saddle and
bridle he has in possession and one Gun he has in possession

4th I give to my Daughter Edna Vicks one negro girl named Harriet and
her increase to her and her heirs forever one Walnut Table

I bind to my wife Eliza Vicks one negro woman named Martha and her increase
during her life and at her death she shall have negro woman Eliza Vick and her increase
to be equally divided between myself Elias Vick and my Daughter Edna
Vicks - I also give to my wife Eliza Vicks one feather bed and four sets of
Linens and gear and a Morgan Saddle and Spinning Wheel. This I give to my
wife to dispose of as she please also all the balance of my property gotten
paying my Just debts I leave to my wife Eliza Vicks during her life and
at her death whatever is left I give to be equally divided between my
