Sekay Thompson of Southampton County & state of North Carolina
being of sound mind and memory, do make and ordain this to be
my last will and testament in manner and form following
to wit - I give to my son William Shadrack Thompson one negro
boy by the name of Little Sam, should my said son die before
he arrives to lawful age or without a lawful child, in that case
I give the said negro to my daughter Frances Thompson, and should
she die without having a lawful heir of her body and in that
case I give the said negro to my daughter Martha Thompson
her and her heirs forever - I give to all my children to wit
Samuel, Burnett, William, Martha & Frances Thompson all the balance
of my estate of what sort soever it may be to them & their heirs forever
I testify - I nominate & appoint my friend William B Lockhart
executor to this my said will. In witness whereof I have set
my hand and seal this 5th day of August One thousand eight
hundred and twenty five - Mary Thompson

Southampton County Court 1827. This last will of Testament
of Mary Thompson ^{deceased} was exhibited in open Court and proved by
the oaths of John D. Amis as to the hand writing of James Barrett
one of the subscribing Witnesses thereto - Whereupon William B.
Lockhart the Executor therein named qualified as the law directs
and ordered to be Certified and recorded -

John Fennell's Will. In the name of god am I John
Fennell of the County of Southampton and state of North Carolina being
of sound mind and memory blessed be god, do make and ordain
this to be my last will and testament in manner and form
following that is to say -

Item I give unto my beloved wife Anne two negro women named Easter
and Deborah also the tract of Land wherein I now live also my stock
of all kinds, also my household and kitchen furniture & plantation
utensils during his natural life and widowhood -

Item I give unto my first born named James, William, Nelson & Matthew
a certain negro boy named Charles to be equally divided between

Item I give unto my two sons named James & Matthew the tract of land
whereon my father in law Matthew Bowles now lives to be equally
divided between the two to them and their heirs forever -

Item I give unto my two sons William & Nelson the tract of land whereon
my mother now lives to be equally divided between the two to them
and their heirs forever also my will and desire is that my two sons
William and Nelson shall have thirty dollars each in money out
of my estate to them and their heirs forever -

Item I give unto my youngest son John A Pennington the tract of land whereon
I now live to him and his heirs forever -

Item I give unto my daughter Nancy one negro girl named Minnie to
her and her heirs forever -

Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth one negro girl named Sidney to
her and her heirs forever -

Item I give unto my daughter Barbara one negro boy named Job to her
and her heirs forever -

Item I give unto my daughter Lucy one negro boy named Banjo to her
and her heirs forever -

Item I give unto my daughter Priscilla one negro boy named Isaac to her
and her heirs forever -

Item I give unto my daughter Mary one negro girl named Hannah to
her and her heirs forever -

also my will and desire is after my wife deceases that the remaining
part of my estate that I have not willed away shall be equally divided
between my dear children to wit named James, Nancy, Elizabeth
William, Nelson, Barbara, Lucy, Matthew, Priscilla, Mary and
John to them and their heirs forever all share and share alike -

And I do hereby ordain my worthy friend Sip Woodard my whole
and sole executor to this my last will and testament disposing all
former will hereby me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this 18th day of October 1821 -
