appointed for all men to die

I Elias Powell of Northampton County et C being of sound mind and memory
do make this writing to containe my last Will and Testament revoking
all others made heretofore by me in manner and forme following
I do give and bequeath to my beloved wife Holland Powell one Negro
man and Sallye Johnson Bob and Bella two Leather Bids and furniture
one Horse named Broke and harned Nancie two Cow and
Calves two Ewes and Lamb two Lambs and Pig & strong Chairs two spin-
ning wheels and two pair Chards the Room and all our two Chest two
Tables and all the kitchen Furniture and Spinning wheels and the Cat
and Whels to her and her heirs forever also the Land wheran I now
live during her natural life or whileswoode

In Item I give and bequeath unto my son Richard Powell one Negro man named
Baptistus and also my land after Death or marriage of my belov
Wife Holland Powell to him and his heirs forever

In Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elias Powell our
negro girl named Eliza Feathr Birds and furniture one cow

and Calf to her and her Heirs forever
I do give and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly Powell our negro girl
Cherry our Leather Bird and Furniture one Cow and Calf to her and her Heirs forever
do
to my wife and dear is it my Will after paying my Just debts that all the remaining
part of my negroes not given away and other Property be equally divided
among all my Children to witt Nancy Johnson, Richard Powell, Ruthen
Powell, and Polly Powell together with their Heirs forever. Also including
my Daughter Isabella Davis two sons named Elias and Richard Powell
and lastly I do nominate and appoint my son Richard Powell my
sole and sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament. I do therefore
givem here unto let my hand and seal this Twenty ninth day of
December one thousand three hundred and eight and thirty two

Elias Vicks Will In the name of God Amen I Elias Vicks
of the County of Northampton State of North Carolina being weak in Body
but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God omnipotent
mild the Master of my body and knowing that I am appointed for the men
to die to make and ordain this my last Will and Testament that
I do say freely and justly of all I give and remanage my Estate into the
Hands of Almighty God that gave it and my Body to be buried in a decent
and Christian forme and as touching such worldly Estate wherewithal I have been
a god to live in this Life I give, devise, and despose of the same in the following
manner and forme

I first I give to my son James Vick the tract of land that he now possess belonging
to land adjoining the Land bounded as follows beginning at a corner post between
a street line to Postmen line thence a street Postline to the run of the Creek thence
up the creek to the corner of Shadwell land thence along said line to Amos Comer
including the exchequer of the land in our tract I give to my son James Vick one Bed
furniture that he has possessed all one horse saddle and bridle that he has possessed
long but one gun before 1817 now

I give the balance of my lands to be equally divided between my two sons Robert
Vick and Henry Vick but my wife Eliza Vick is to have the privilege of one
third part thereof during her life

I give to my son Elias Vick one negro boy name Joshua also one saddle and
bridle he has in possession and one gun he has in possession

4th I give to my Daughter Edna Vick one negro girl name Harriet and
her increase to her and her heirs forever one Walnut Table

I bind to my wife Eliza Vick our negro woman named Martha and her increase
during her life and at her death she shall have negro woman Eliza Vick and her increase
equal to be equally divided between myself Elias Vick and my Daughter Edna
Vick - I also give to my wife Eliza Vick one feather bed and four sets of
Linens and gear and a Morgan Saddle and Spinning Wheel. This I give to my
wife to dispose of as she please also all the balance of my property gotten
paying my Just debts I leave to my wife Eliza Vick during her life and
at her death whatever is left I give to be equally divided between my

Three Sons and my Daughter namely Eliza Vick, Parkam Vick Henry Vick and Edna Vick
I Constitute make and remain James H. Wood the sole Executor of this
my last Will and Testament and I confirm this and do set by to carry
out all in this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 17th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand

my land and plantation also all my Cattle that is now growing
also all the estate that I am now in possession of (after paying all
my just debts, bothen and out doors) during her natural life or
widowhood

Thirdly it is my wish and desire that on the death or marriage
of my wife Sally Gaines all my land and the balance of
my estate be sold and equally divided among my eight children
Henry, Elizabeth, Michael, Mary, James, Marion, John Wesley and
Seneca Gaines to them and their heirs forever
it is my wish that the beds which my late Son Christopher and his
sons have had to occupy to them be valued and included in
this part of Legacy

I do hereby nominate and appoint my friend Jonathan Williams
my late and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament
revising and making void all Wills heretofore made by me
it is my wish that I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day

Shore as the first Item

Item No 4 I bind unto my friend Lazarus & his wife & their
children also the negro Henrietta Little King for his Masterous
service that I give to her above named king for part of the above named
which I give to her above named King I bind unto the 3股 King to share the same
with any other he pleases on the trust of & and above named Lazarus & his wife
and child Abby & her husband for & it is also my will that the above
given to King for the support of him every year During his life of & his wife &
