 the testator found writing and percy believe the said writing and
 the name thereto subscribed to be wholly written by the testator's own
 hand, whereupon the said writing is ordered to be recorded, as the
 true last will and testament of the said John L. Withers Jr. and
 the Court certifies that it was satisfactory proved in open Court that
 the said Will was found among the valuable papers of the said
 John L. Withers Jr. and in the meters of the said Edmund
 Withers the Executor therein named, who made oath thereto
 according to Law and together with John L. Withers, Williams
 W. Withers and Edward T. Bradman his securities entered
 into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of One thousand
 thousand dollars conditioned, as the Law directs, Certificate is
 granted him for obtaining a probate of said Will in due
 form.
