In the name of God Amen the 2nd of August 1827
I George White son of Andrew White being in a perfect state
of body health at the time of sound mind & memory but
knowing it is appointed for all men once to die do make
this my last will & testament in the following manner—
I do hereby bequeath to be paid each to be buried in
a decent Christian like manner I do bequeath such worldly
estate as it may please God to bless me with in this life
I give and dispose of in the manner then the said George
White particularly described that is to say—
First I bequeath & confirm in this my last will the first & utmost
part of my wife Nancy in the event of her surviving me in
this life to all the property specifically named & pointed out
in a deed of gift made by me to my son Robert White
to all the property specifically named & pointed out in a
deed of gift made by me to my son George White to the
said Nancy my wife together with every article of apparel
furniture or otherwise as it is declared in the aforesaid
deeds of gift without fraud or deception of either the said
Robert White or the said George White according to the true
intent & meaning of the said deeds of gift aforesaid—
I also give & bequeath unto my wife Nancy an iron
stove (called Iron light) one Ratch bed of furniture one fine
table half dozen sitting chairs one set of erectory ware
one case of linen forty one new pot, kettles and spiders
two new tables five new chairs one new floor to be the highest
I also have my wife Nancy during her natural life the
negro girl named Fido
