 plantation wherein he now lives which is one half of the
 land common I now live being about four acres more
 & less to him this being forever.

Then I give & bequeath unto my son Samuel Guthrie the house
 and land whereing I now live after my loving wife decess
 which she is to have in natural life & after her decess
 to belong to the said Samuel Guthrie & his heirs forever which
 is the balance of all my land & things both joining each
 other the division line is to run due north & south also
 a mile or more & full

I then give & bequeath unto my son William Guthrie fifty
 acres of land joining his sister Samuel Guthrie and ap-
 pertained to him & his heirs forever.

I make my true & loving wife Mary Guthrie my true
 Samuel Guthrie my whole & sole executory of this my

Last will & testament as witness my hand this 28th day
 of October 1828 at home written
