In the Name of God Amen I Brice Bender of the County of Onslow and State of North
Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory (Blessed be God) do this fifth
day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen
make and publish this my last Will and testament in manner following that is to
Say;

I give and bequeath my Soul to Almighty God who gave it and my body to be decently
buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named and my funeral expenses
to be paid out of my estate first-----

My will further is that all my Just debts be paid out of my estate here after
named for that purpose that is to say I wish all my debts collected and my tiny
land on water creek containing four hundred acres and my two houses and lots with
their improvements and my store house and stables and part of a lot that they stand
upon all situated in the town of Swansborough and all the navel stores that I
know have on hand a horse two charer and harness and the stock of goods now on
hand to be sold by my executors and the money arising from the sale to be collected
with the money that is now due me to pay the demands that I know have on hand
purchased of Lent and Co. I wish returned provided they will take them as they
were invoiced to me in payment for them and if not for them to be sold as directed
above with the other property and the balance that may be remaining after all my
debts be paid to be disposed of as follows that is to Say,

I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Alice one half of my land being in Carteret
County that I lot of Allen Back house containing by estimation seventeen hundred
and some odd acres as will more fully appear by the deeds I know hold the land by
or reference to the courses of that deed during her natural and the other half I
give to the child my Wife is now pregnant with when it comes to age or marries
and should it die before it comes to age or marries the hole of the land I give
and bequeath to my beloved Wife to her her heirs and assigns forever and the
decease of my Wife the half of the land I give her life estate in I give and
bequeath to my Child should it then be living to its heirs and assigns forever
and lastly I give and bequeath to be equally divided between my wife and the child
that she know is pregnant with the following property three negro men by the names
of Charles Louis and Cesar two negro women by the names of Chana Silva and a boy
by the name of Cesar and five girls by the names of Betta and Delila and Linala
and Heriott and Mara and all of my house hold and kitchen furniture including all
my estate both real and personal Should the child die before it comes to age or
marries my wife to have the hole of the negroes and furniture as above in the lands
to her her heirs and assigns forever as other the balance of the money arising
from the sales of the property left to be sold to pay my debts to be equally
divided as above between my wife and the child the know pregnant with and in case of
the child should die before it arrives to the age above written then its part both
real and personal to go to my wife her heirs and assigns forever I hereby make
and ordain my worthy friend Daniel M. Dulany my Executor to this my last will and
testament in witness whereof I the Said Brice Bender have to this my last will
and testament Set my hand and seal the day and the year above written in the
presence of us .

Carolina and being in good health and sound and perfect mind and memory thanks
be God for it therefore and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing
I am appointed for all one to die do make and ordain this my last will and
testament in manner and form as following that is to say Principally and First
of all I Recommend my Soul into the hand of Almighty God who give it hoping
through the Mercy of Jesus Christ to have free and full pardon of all my sins
and so Inherit Eternal Life and my body Comit to the Earth to be buried in a
Christian Burial according to the Descretion of my Executors here after
do omit nothing dating but at the General Resurrection I Shall Review the same
again by the Mighty power of God and for what Worldly Estate it hath Pleased
God to Bless me with in this life I give and dispose of the Same in manner
and form followeth-----

First I Will and Ordain that all my Just Debt and funeral Expenses be fully
paid and Satisfied-----

Item: I give unto my two Sons Richard Basden & John Basden all my lands to be
Equal divided between the two Sons and all the Plantation tools one bed and
furniture to Each Son and also I give one Negro man Named Prince to the sons
and Raise and Support the sd. Children.

Item: I give unto my Daughters Nancy Basden one Negro boy Named Artor I give
to my Daughter Nancy Basden and her heirs for Every and also I give to my
Daughter Elizabeth Basden one Negro girl Named Beck and her increases to be
Equal divided between the four Children when his youngest Son becomes of Age
one Bed and furniture to Each Daughter to their heirs for Every.

Item: I give unto Sarah Harris one bed and furniture My stocks of all kinds
to be Equal divided between my four Children when John Basden becomes
twenty one years of Age I do hereby nominate and appoint my loving Brother
Jesse Basden and Lewis Jones to be my whole and Soul Executors of this my
last Will and Testament I do hereby declare and pronounce this to be my last
will and Testament in Witness where of I have here unto set my hand and Seal
this 20th of December 1800-
