Item: I give and bequeath unto Joseph Rhoads alias Joseph Johnston son of Patience five shillings current money to him and his heirs and assigns for Ever.

Item: I give and bequeath unto Cyrenus Black alias John Johnston son of Patience five shillings current money to him and his heirs and assigns for Ever.

Item: I give and bequeath unto Mary Greor Daughter of Patience five shillings current money to her and her heirs and assigns for Ever.

Item: My will and Desire further is that all the remaining part of my Estate that is other ways disposed of in this will be sold at publick vendue at six months Credit and the money arising from such sale be applied to the payment of my debts and legacies with all moneys that may be owing to me and after my just debts and legacies is paid if any remain I give the same to my son Benjamin Johnston to him and his heirs and assigns for Ever.

And I do hereby Nominate and appoint my Trusty and good friends Jess Williams and Nathaniel Loomis Esquires and my son Jonas Johnston my whole and sole Executors of this my last will and testament utterly revoking and disannulling all other or former wills testaments bequeaths or Executions heretofore by me made or named and I do hereby further publish pronounce and declare this and no other to be my last will and testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and seal this the Fourth Day of March in twenty fifth year of American Independence and the Year of Our Lord Christ One thousand Eight Hundred and One.

In the Name of God Amen, I John Jarrott of the State of North Carolina & County of Onslow being sick & weak of Body but of sound mind and memory, Thanks to God, knowing that its the common lot of all to die, Do make and ordain this as my last will & testament with respect to such worldly goods as it hath pleased God to bless me & Desire that it may be disposed of in manner following (Viz) My first desire is that my Body be decently Buried at the discretion of my Executors to be hereafter named.

Item: I desire that all my Just Debts be faithfully paid.

Item: I give unto my Sister Rhoda Gornto all my Lands & the implements thereon during her life & at her death to her heirs forever. Also all my stock of Hogs, Horses & Cattle all my House hold furniture & Plantation Tools also my Canoe & stock of bees, & handmill, & Horse Cart to her during her life & at her death whatever shall be remaining to be equally divided among her heirs & to them forever.

Item: My desire that all the residue of my Property not before given shall be sold at six month Credit and what ever monies shall remain after my Debts are paid I give to my Sister Rhoda Gornto forever. And I do hereby constitute my good friends William Hrench & John Gornto Executors of this my last will & testament. Utterly revoking & disannulling all others by me heretofore made, declaring this to be my last in witness whereof I have hereunto Set my name and affixed my Seal this 24th Day of April in the year of our Lord 1804.

FIRST: I Recommend my Soul to God who gave it in hopes of a glorias Engagment of him through a mediator of a blessed redeemer,

SECONDLY: I Recommend my body to the earth from whence it was taken in hopes of a Joyful Resurrection at the Last Judgment to be buried in a decent & Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors:

And touching such worldly effects as God has blessed me with I dispose of in the manner following:

IFRST: I give and bequeath to my dear and Loving wife Sarah Jenkins my three my three feather beds together with all and sole my household furniture & Kitchen utensils of all and every description without any reserve whatever to her her heirs & assigns forever. Also my mare bridle & saddle like wise three Cows & Calves. She to have her choice of my stock also four sows and sixteen Pigs and fourteen one year old hogs to her her heirs and assigns forever. It also is my Will that my aforesaid wife Sarah Jenkins shall have the full possession & use of all & every part or parcel of my land for & during the term of her natural life. And at the death of my said wife Sarah Jenkins I give & devise said land to my son John Jenkins & the heirs of his body lawfully begotten or assigns forever & in default whereof or of such heirs or at his deceased the said land at my wife deceased to be sold and the profits arising therefrom to be equally divided between my brother Elish Jenkins & my step-daughter Ann Hadnot I also give and bequeath to my der wife Sarah Jenkins all my plantations tools & implements of husbandry of every description to her her heirs & assigns forever. an also all the corn and bacon in her possession at my deceased. It is also my Will that my oxen & all the residue of my personal estate to be sold & after my just debts are paid the remaining profits arising from such sale I give to my wife Sarah Jenkins whom I also appoint & constitute Executrix of this my Last Will & Testament I do hereby revoke all former Wills & testamentary by me formerly made Witness my hand Seal this 7th day of March & year of Our Lord 1804.
