It is also my will & desire that all my just debts be paid
by my executors hereafter named out of the money in hand
of my & the debts due me of every description & after paying
such debts as is made appear to be justly due from the
money & debts aforesaid the balance of said money & debts
be it more or less to be equally divided between Robert
White & George White my son & John Young & William &
Thompson my sons in law to them their heirs & assigns forever

I also give to my wife Mrs William Centers an wearing
belt a dress & a collar & a pair of shoes & a saddle & bridle an upper
leg iron & a Kelly together with a pair of shoes
to him his heirs & assigns forever

I also constitute and appoint my son Robert & White
my son George White Executors to this my will & having all
other & unknown having this to be my only will & disposition
of the property herein named which said will is written
on the first side between the 26th & 27th lines with the word
know & on the second side between the 16th & 17th lines with
the word Kelly & also written on the said second side
between the 29th & 30th lines with the words in my presence
two witnesses & Kelly & in addition to this my will

I also give & bequeath unto my son George all my household
furniture plantation tools of every description together
with what feathers I have in hand to him his heirs & assigns forever

I the balance of my stock of horses cattle hogs & sheep my crop
growing for land & my property the balance of it not then
bequeathed or by me or other to be disposed of of every description

I give & bequeath equally to my son Robert & George (or executor
that then the said Robert & George Executors to this my will
all of which I have distinctly & expressly of in testimony
whereof I the said George White have hereunto set my
hand & seal this 25th of August A.D. 1837
at Shreve Blount
