THIRDLY: It is my will and desire that none of my land or negroes be sold but that my land be rented and negroes be hired out if found necessary to discharge my debts.

FOURTHLY: It is my will and desire that my wife Alice Loomis have the use of one -third part of all my land during the term of his natural life.

FIFTHLY: It is my will and desire that all my personal estate consisting of me negroes cattle horses ,hogs sheep household and kitchen furniture and plantation costs after and all other personal estate after the payment of my just debts be equally divided into three parts as equally as can be done and that one third part go to my wife, Alice Loomis and the other two -thirds to my three brothers Simon Loomis, Solomon Loomis and Spraharas Loomis to them their heirs Executors and Administrators and assigns forever.

SIXTLY: It is my will that if ther is a surplus of money arising from my bonds notes, and accounts after paying my just debts it is my will that it be divided as directed for my personal estate.

ITEM: I, will and bequeath to my son William Landen this plantation whereon I now live after my wife's widowhood without my said wife Aliff does not live on said plantation then and in that case for said plantation to be rented for use of said William Landen also I will and bequeath to my son William Landen one two year old hefier, to his heirs and assigns forever, Also I will that if my son William Landen could not live to the age of twenty one years that my son John should be his only heirs.

ITEM: I, Will and bequeath that, when my son William comes to the age of twenty one years, that he and my son James shall pay to my son John Landen Fifty Dollars

a piece to be levied out of their goods and chattles, lands and tenements.

If the or as many of the children as may be of age or married at the above division they or either are to draw in the most legal manner and receive accordingly which I give to them he or she , to their heirs and assigns forever.

Then my whole estate to be kept together by keeping the negroes and stock and the lands rented out or employing mannager as my Executor may think beat.

A division to be in like manner as all the children may come to age or marry as the above which I give to them their heirs and assigns forever, including if a daughter and equal part with all my daughters all my lands on New River or the waters thereof on New River Sanks, reserving the plantation and sufficient
