ONSLow COUNTY:

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN: I Phebe Landen, of the County aforesaid, being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory desires my Last Will and Testament in the following manner and form.

ITEM: I give and bequeath to my grandson John Landen two cows and calves and one steer one sow and four pigs one large Chest, one feather bed firmiture one dish, two basons, Three plates six spoons, three earthen plates two bowls, one tumbler, one frying pan, one not, one dutch oven, one Lining Wheel one wollen wheel, one pair of cards, one churn, tub one pair two pigskins one smoothing iron, and all my plantation tools. To him his heirs and assigns forever.

ITEM: I give to my daughter Nancy Parker five shillings to her her heirs and assigns forever.

I lend to my daughter Nancy Parker one cow and yearling, one large barrow one bed, one zig, one lining wheel, two wooden bowls, one wooden dish, one pewter dish, two puter basins, three puter plates, six spoons, three earthen plates, two bowls, one not, the above articles is lent to my daughter induring her life at her decease, I desire that my grandson Bryant Parker should have it to him his heirs and assigns forever.

ITEM: I give to my son James Landen Five Shillings to him his heirs and assigns forever.

ITEM: I give to the heirs of my son Stephen Landen deceased, Five shillings to them their heirs and assigns forever.

I constitute and appoint my friend Joseph Marshborn, Executor to this my Last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and offer my seal, This 22nd of March 1805.

In The Name of God Amen: I James Lane of the County of Onslow State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God do this twenty seventh of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine make this my last will and Testament.

FIRST: That all my just debts be paid.

ITEM: I give unto my Daughter Sarah Lane ^{partly} four acres of land, to be the same more or

less beginning at a poplar on a branch joining Tho's Ennett line then running across the old field about East corner to Persimmons Branch to a White Oak running up the said Branch to a little slash make out the said branch to the head of its. To a white thence running a straight course to a litewood stump then strate course to his old line to a gum this I give by a deed of gift.

ITEM: I give unto my son James Lane sixty acres of land be the same more or less and also four head of cattle.

ITEM: I lend unto my beloved Wife Sedda Lane during her life the Plantation and Plantation tools of all kinds the horses, hogs, the sows and pigs and all the rest of my cattle household and furniture and at her decease to be divided among the three children.

ITEM: I give unto my son William Lane thirty acres of land be the same more or less lying on Turkey Creek joining Brice's land.

And hereby make and ordain my Worthy friend John Spicer executor of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof the said James Lane have to this my last Will and Testament. Set my hand and seal the day and year above written.

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN: I Stephen Landing of Onslow County being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory, desires this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following, (viz) After my just debts are fully satisfied and paid. I give and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Landing, my ^{plantation} plantation whereon I now live, during her life, & at decease I desire that my son Eliza Landing shall have all my rite of lands to him his heirs and assigns forever, & in case my son Eliza should die without lawful heirs, I desire that my lands should be equally divided between my two daughters Submetta & Henrietta Landing to them their heirs and assigns forever.

ITEM: I give to my wife Elizabeth my mare bridle and saddle, & one feather bed and furniture during her life together with all my household furniture, except two feather beds & furniture, one of which beds I give to my son Eliza & the other to my daughter Submetta Landing.

ITEM: I give one cow and calf to my son Eliza, I give one cow and calf to my daughter Submetta one cow and calf to my daughter Henrietta.

Item; I leave one cow & calf & three steers to be sold to pay my debts.

ITEM: I leave all the rest of my stock cattle and hogs to my wife Elizabeth during her life, at her decease to be equally divided between my three children, Eliza, Submetta, & Henrietta Landing to them their heirs and assigns forever.

ITEM: I lend to my wife Elizabeth Landing also my plantation, utensils during her life, I do constitute and appoint my friends James Foy & Nathan Murray my whole & sole executors to this my last will and Testament, In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal, This the 10th day of Jany A.D. 1803.
