AND the residue & remaining part of my property both real & personal I lend unto my beloved wife Salome Eubank during her Widowhood, & at the day of her marriage or death I will & bequeath unto Beloved daughter Mattha Eubank one negroe girl named Judith & her increase forever also at the death or marriage of my beloved wife aforesaid I will and bequeath unto my daughter Alice Eubank one negroe girl named Edney & her increase forever, Also at the death or marriage of my beloved wife aforesaid I will and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Salome Eubank one Negroe girl named Anaky & her increase forever. Also I will and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Cassandra Eubank at the Death or marriage of my beloved wife aforesaid, one negroe woman named Linda & her increase from the date of this my last will forever. Also at the death or marriage of my beloved wife I will & bequeath unto my beloved grandson Thomas Eubank son of John My riding mare & bridle & saddled her increase to him & his heirs forever & if the said mare is not living at my death I will & bequeath in the aforesaid manner unto my aforesaid grandson the best horse kind that I am possessed of at the day of my death. Also at the death or marriage of my beloved wife aforesaid I will & bequeath unto my beloved grandson aforesaid all the lands and premises that I am possessed of at the day of my death. Also at the death or marriage of my aforesaid wife beloved wife I will & bequeath unto my daughter Loice, & my five sons, to wit, Ezekial, John, Elisha, Eliah & Isaac, Equally all of my stock of everykind & all my plantation tools, to them & their heirs forever, Also at the death or marriage of my beloved wife aforesaid, I will and bequeath unto my beloved daughter aforesaid, to wit, Cassandra, Alice, Salome, & Martha, all of my house hold furniture whatsoever & whatsoever to be Equally divided amongst them, And I do nominate constitute & appoint my beloved Brother John Eubank & my trusty friend William Hellen Executors to this my last will & testament Whom I give full power and authority to sell and dispose of any part of my property that they shall think proper for the support of my beloved wife aforesaid as they shall see need, & also if they shall think it best I desire that they shall hire out the negroes at private sale at their own discretion for the support of my aforesaid beloved wife, And revoking all other my former will or wills legacies bequests & Executors by me before made or given I do ratify & confirm this to be my last will & testament, in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 6th day of June in the year of Our Lord 1807-----

ITOM: I give unto my son John Erexson his heirs and assigns forever when come of the age of twenty one years Half of my land where I now live and also further give to my son John Erexson, the other half of my land at his mother death to him his heirs and assigns forever, Also one feather-bed and furniture also I give my son John one half of the remainder of my stock that is not Willed to my wife at the age of twenty one years.

ITEM: I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Erexson at the age of eighteen or married one feather bed and furniture and one half of the residue off my stock not willed to my wife of all kinds my Will and desire is that my wife Elizabeth Erexson have the use of all my personal estate whatever that is not mentioned in my will during her natural life And then at her death to be equally divided between my two children John and Elizabeth. I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth Erexson and Edwd Ward my whole sole Executors February 13, 1800.

Item: I Also Nominate and appoint my beloved wife and my Brother Charles

Eagerton my hole and sole Executors to this my Last Will & Testament Revoking & Rescinding all former wills and acknowledging this to be my Last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 28th day of December 1801

My will is that all my just debts be first paid out of what money may due me and the sale of my negro man Charles who I leave to be sold and a credit of six months,.

ITEM: I give and bequest beloved son Donie fifty acres of land lying in Wells fork on the North side of Cow Head Creek and also give him fifteen acres more being in Jumperun Neck which John Gornto was to make deed to when I which I wish made to my son Daniel.

I lend to my beloved wife Rebecca the houses and cleared land adjoining them as far as a small locust tree in then Peach Orchard and through the neck so as to include my field on Bear Head during her natural Life.

ITEM: I Give the cleared land on Wallaces Creek side and the balance of my Peach Orchard and all on the North Side of the line both cleared and Wood land to be Equally divided between my two daughters Polle and Elizabeth them & their heirs forever, I mean North of the line from the Locust tree To the mouth of Bear head .

ITEM: I Give at the death of my wife the lands that I lent her to be Equally divided amongst all my children according to quantity & Qualit, including my youngest daughter Elan as well as above named children .

ITEM: I Give to my son Daniel my young mare and her increase to him and his heirs forever I think I have made ample Provisions for paying my just debts and I wish three of my neighbors called in to divide my sock and furniture of every description Equally between my wife four children and should there be any money left out of the appropraiton to pay my debts I give to be equally divided amongst my wife and four children, and wish and equally division amongst them in any thing that I may have amitted to mention .

ITEM: I give Wallen Brown five shotes.

I Leave my beloved wife my Soul Executrix to this my Last Will and Testament revoking all Will by me made hereto fore in Testamony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 8 Day of April 1823.

ITEM: My Will and desire further is that my negroes be equally divided, and one half to go to my daughter Elizabeth Dudley & the other half to be equally divided between Ketsa Waters, and her son Edward - my will further is that no part of my Negroes be Sold.-----

ITEM: My will and desire further is that the plantation on which I now live and, I do hereby give and bequest unto my beloved Daughter the said plantation to her and her heirs forever at the time of her Coming to the age of twenty one years or marries.-----

ITEM: I give & bequest unto the Son of Ketsy Warters by the name of Edward, my other plantation known by the name of the Hall plantation to him and his heirs for Ever reserving the use of the the said plantation to his Mother Ketsy Warters
