 in silver already received one negro man by the name
 Friday 2 cows & calves one yoke of Oxen 2 Hogs one horse
 2nd I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sanderson
 nine pieces of gold one hundred & ten dollars of silver
 already received 3 negroes by the name of Tracts -
 Rachel & Brackton cows & calves & one Dorrell Ward one
 riding Chair two beds one yoke of Oxen -
 3rd I give & bequeath unto my son Brian the lands &
 plantation whereon I now live containing 650 acres.

 in care of her, God willing, that her children Patey & Will &
 her increase & children, by name Mary & Will & one horse two
 cows & calves 9 pieces of gold one hundred & ten dollars silver
 already received & one yoke of Oxen -
 4th I give & bequeath unto my son Pompey 9 pieces of gold
 one hundred & ten dollars silver already received one piece
 of land lying in Jones County to be divided between him
 & Paul Pompey to have the west part, one negro girl
 by the name of Ester her cows one horse 2 beds & 2 yokes of
 5th I give & bequeath unto my son David 9 pieces of gold
 one hundred & ten dollars silver already received I give & bequeath
 the East part of my ^{part} land in Jones County freed negroes by
 the name of Ebenezer, Will & Rachel one horse two cows
 2 beds & one yoke of Oxen -
 6th I have my Banks lands to be divided amongst my
 all my children
 And I hereby make & ordain Paul & Eliza & Hannah & Rachel
 Executors to this my last will & testament
 utterly disallow, revoke & disannul all & every other
 former testaments, wills, legacies, bequests & Executors by
 me in ~~any~~ ^{any} former named wills & bequeathed ratifying
 & confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament in
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 17th
 day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred & twenty eight
