In the name of God Amen this 20th of October 1823
I Joel Wilder of Andover County a Farmer by occupation being
in a poor state of bodily health but of my usual understand-
ing & Reasoning it is appointed for all men once to die
to make this my last will & Testament in the following
words first I recommend my soul to the care of my
redemptor & my body to its Parent Earth & then coming
my worldly Estate I dispose of it in the following manner that
is to say -

I Give to my beloved wife Maria during her natural
life my negro woman Slav Wida then Eldst son Shadrach
then next eldest son Julius then daughter Selah together
with their increase & also my stock of Cattle my hogs
and horses during her natural life & at my wife's death
such part of my Cattle hogs & my house if then alive
together with my negro woman Wida, boy Shadrach & Julius
& Selah & all their increase to be equally divided
between my following Children - that is to say my
son James & my Daughters Lavinia, Fanny, Betsy, Anna &
Julia to them their heirs & assigns forever.

I also Give my beloved wife Maria all my beds
bedstead & furniture my household & Kitchen Furniture
& my plantation tools of every description during the
term of her natural life & at her death the last
named property to be equally divided between my
sons & daughters Anna Wilder, my Grandson Joel Wilder
& the heirs male & female of my daughter Selah

to them their heirs & assigns forever -
 I give & Equate to my son Malachi Wilder the sum
 of ten dollars to him his heirs & assigns forever which
 gift of ten dollars to Malachi is not intended to
 make his accountings with my executors due after having
 for some amount due me in a judgment & was
 held against him which judgment I regret to since
 against a note of Malachi held against me in
 an old account of Malachi against John A. Smith &
 John Kennedy of Daphn County Connecticut to be
 my last will & Testament all other wills & acknowledgments
 to be my will in testimony whereof I have set
 my hand & seal this, inserted

In the name of God amen. I John Mallick being in
 a poor state of health but of sound & perfect memory I give
 beget for it do this day make & publish this my last
 will & Testament in manner following to wit -
 1st I give & Equate to my son Abijah H. Mallick all that
 piece of land lying in the many branch bought of Say
 Wagon together with four negroes to wit - Estlin Enock
 Hannah & Lucy with one bed bedstead & furniture -
 2nd I give unto my son Francis Mallick all the land bought
 of Abby & Mabel that bought of Say Wagon a joining it
 together with four negroes to wit - Eliza, Henry, Abby, Edwidge,
 & Harriet with one bed bedstead & furniture & my new canoe
 I have equally bequeath Francis, Mallick & Allen Mallick.
 3rd I give unto my son William B. Mallick all that land
 lying in Carter County bought of Benjamin Davis & wife
 together with all the land bought of William Davis & wife
 in the County of Carter together with five negroes to wit -
 Tabalasa, David, Pat & the child Hester & Edmund with one
 bed, bedstead & furniture he can use also my great & fifteen
 dollars extra of the present years work which I wish to be di-
 vided between William, John & Allen Mallick.
 4th I give unto my son John Mallick all the land bought of
 Abby & Edward Starkey together with five negroes to wit -
 Isaac, Luke, Sam, Socks & Pardon together with one bed
 bedstead & furniture also my large canoe.
 5th I give unto my son Allen Mallick all the land bought
 of Samuel Gray & John Starkey on which I now live
