First of All: I most humbly recommend my soul to the extensive mercy of that All Wise Supreme Inteligent Being who gave it to me! most earnestly at the same time deprecating his Justice .-

Item 3rd: I give devise and bequeath unto my second son Christopher Jones, One Dollar .

Item 4th: I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Martha Barber, one Dollar, to them & their heirs forever.

Item:5th: I authorise my Executors to sell to the best advantage and to convey the tract of land whereon Isaac Barber now lives, containing by estimation eighty five acres, and the proce ds thereof after deducting necessary charges t to be equally divided among my three children already named, Cartaret, Christop her Martha Barber, heirs & assignes forever.

Item 6th: My will and desire is that My Executors be supreme arbitors in all controversis that may arise and happen among y helps and lyatees and that their decission shall be final or conclusive without recourse to any other person or persons, or any Court of Judicative chatever.

Item 7th: I lend unto my Wife Mary Jones and my youngest Son Hezerlah Jones Item (an: I tend unto me wife Larry Jones and my youngest Son Here Lang Jones during their matural lives, jointly a severely to same and amove alike the Land whereon I now live which I purchased of James Smith containing by estimation 135 acres---- Also all my stock of any study of the Heres. Cattle, Hogs, furniture, farming utenils of every sind and description under the care and superintendance of my Executors as Trustees for their use and benefit only superintendance of my Executors as Transdess for their use and occurring their natural lives—— and after the dicase of both, said property to deems and se equally divided among the heirs of said Heritsen lawfully desotten in wedlock forever——— But in falare of such heirs (after the decease of both, The same to be sold by my Executors and after deducting necessary charges the proceeds thereof to be equally devided among my other children then, their heirs, and assigns forever----

Last of all I hereby nominate and appoint my friend William Hellen and Robert Dickson Executors of this my last will and testement siving and granting unto them full and dese tionary powers, also revoking all others by me made acknowling

Item: Negro Fellow Joe, Castallia and Negro woman Amy to be sold at six months credit my Home lot & all the furniture at six & twelve monthly all the rest & recidue of my property to be sold in like manner and the proceeds thereof to be applied. applied to the payment of my Debts, If what I have bequeathed is more than sufficient to discharge my debts he Resider to got on wy Sister Alice Hender to her, her hers and assigns forever and if what I have allotted to discharge my bebts is insufficient Each and everyome of the heirs except Nancy Bell to pay their proportionable part out of what I have given them.
