After my wife decease, my will and desire of my wife land that I left to my wife during her natural life being the land I purchased of James Keble and John Lester to my son Morris and his heirs and assigns forever, The residue not mentioned in my Will to Pay debts.

Lastly, I Constitute make and appoint my son Fredrick Foy, and Joshua Foy my whole and Sole Executors this my Last Will and Testament revoking all others Wills and Testaments by me hereto fore made. And I do hereby desire my Executors above mentioned to do their duty in full.

Item: I lend unto my beloved wife Mary Fields during her widowhood two Negroes (Namely) Pleasant & Kitt My Riding mare bridle & Saddle two Cows & Calves and all of my house hold and kitchen furniture except one bed, stead and furniture, I also lend afore said to my wife all the lands tenements Sitree whereon I now live & shall hereafter Bequeath to my son Moses Judge Fields-----

Item: I give and bequeath unto my son Council Fields
or parcel of lands lying in sd. County
on the south side of Whittock river
Josiah Smith & the plantation

Beginning at sd. river in the mouth of a dreen or swamp that makes up between two points of high land Cal'd Piny Point & Cupies Island Running up and with the same Southwardly to three large Short strawd pines, standing in or above the head of S'd. swamp or weane by the upper Corner of Joseph Calloways Old field, runing thence South thirty seven East One Hundred and Eighteen Poles to a small white oak by the side of the main road. Thence South twenty eight East sixty Poles, thence South thirty two and a half East one Hundred and forty five Poles to a gum My Corner Standing in the edge of the peccoon, On the West side of Josiah Smith Plantation Bpoit his house, Thence with S'd Smiths line North One West one Hundred and thirty five poles to a water oak my own & Caleb Smiths Corner Standing in Maides pond thence with said Smiths line to the river thence up & with the River to the Beginning including all the lands Tenements & Setra within said lines also I give and bequeath unto my son Council one negro named Oria And one half of negro man named Charles after the Death of my Mother Rebekah Fields, to him the S'd Council his heirs and assigns forever -----

Item: I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rachel Smith All the lands tenements & Setree which I now Own below the fork branch Joifings Frankses lands On the South Side of S'd Whittock River as will appear by the title papers, Also I give and bequeath to my S'd daughter Rachel one negro Woman named Diana Also a Somel horse Cal'd Hall, One Bedd, Stead & furniture & one Chest, to her heirs and assigns forever. -----

Item: I give and bequeath unto my son Moses Judges Fields all & singular Lands Tenements & Setree lying on the south side of the S'd Whittock River that lies above the upper line of the lands which I have given to my son Council as before described including the plantation whereon I now Live only reserving the term of my wifes widowhood to her and for her use-----
Also I give & Bequeath unto my said son Moses Judge Fields three negro boys and Negro girls Namely, March, George Sam, and Hepsay also Negro Pleasant and Kitt after the term of My Wifes Widowhood which I have already Lent Also onr Horse Cal'd Sweper & all of my Cattle Hogs House hold & Kitchen furniture & Plantation tools of everykind and three Set Guns, Except such articles as I heretofore give away, I further Charge and request my Son Moses Judge to take care and support my Wife during her Widowhood. And I do hereby Ordain Constitute and Appoint my two Sons Council & Moses Judge Fields my Trusty & Lawful Executors to this my Last Will & Testament in Testamony whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this the 17th day of May ---- 1816

Item; I give and bequeath to my son Richard Ward Fields, One Hundred Dollars at the end of three years from my dease and sooner if convenient by my Executors.

Item: I authorise my Executor to pay my daughter Rebasa an annuity of five dollars pr annum I also give her one dollar, heirs and assigns.

Item: I give my son three years after my deese Brice Fields understood One Hundred Dollars heirs & assigns.

Item: I lend unto my daughter Dorothy Williamston during her natural life to be under her controlled use absolutely and no other person or persons- Negro Woman Jude & her increase of the present day & those they may have hereafter- After her demise (Dorothy Williamston) to deemed to the heirs of her body forever----

Item: I land to my Daughter Ann Scott Negro Rose and increase except a life estate in Girl Sal to her use and benefit only-after her demise to deemed to the heirs of her body each to sherealike forever.

Item: I lend to my daughter Narcissa Fields during the term of her natural life Negro woman Young Fan to absolute and benefit only and after her demise to land to the heirs of her body also the increase of the present day & then they may have hereafter forever.

Item: I lend to my daughter Vashti one Negro called Phillis and increase at present Two children named Hardy and Ben during the term of her life to her use and a controll only after her demise to deemed to the heirs of her body each to share alike forever.

Item: I give and bequeath unto my son Jacob Fields all my lands and tenements above Wallices branch, said branch between my residence of the heirs of my late brother Aaron Fields, him and assigns forever. ----I also give him my black smith tools, one bed & cest in his possession.

Finally I Constitute and appoint my son Jacob and wife Huldah Executors of this will revoking all others in testimony I the said Jacob Fields Senior have signed the same with my hand the 13th day of February 1823.

I James Fields of Onslow County in the State of North Carolina being in a Very low State of Health but of Sound mind & perfect Memory, thanks be to God Calling to mind the Certainty of Death & the uncertainty of the time and manner of it But Desirous while I have Opportunity to Dispose of Such Worldly Estate God has pleased to Bless me With Do make this my Last Will and Testament, In manner & form following,

(VIZ)

First, I Will & Bequeath to my beloved wife Rebecca that part of the plantation that we now make of During her natural Life, I also lend her the use of a Negro fellow Known by the name of Tom During her natural Life, and afterwards I give and bequeath this said fellow to my Son Aron, I also Lend to her one Negro boy Known by the name of Charles Durn her Natural Life, & afterwards to be the fourmentioned Charles to be Equally divided between my two Eldest Sons Jacob & Moses, I also lend her my Stock of all kinds that I now possess During her Natural Life & afterwards to be Equally Devided Between my three Children

Item: I give to my beloved Wife One Feather Bed, I also lend her all the plantation tools together with all my Household furniture that I now possess During her Natural Life & afterwards to be Equally Devided Between my three Children-----

Item: I will & bequeath to my Son Jacob all the land that I now possess above Hawkins Branch, I also give to my Son Jacob the land I bought of Samuel Fields joining James Atkins Land, & the Land I took up joining the same also, I give & bequeath to my Son Jacob one bed and furniture, & also it is my Deser Heirs of the above mentioned Hawkins Branch Down to a Cypress Stump Standing by the Run of the said branch and Running thence Due North to the run of Whittock River that the said line shall be the established deviding line between the lands of my Sons Jacob and Aron Fields agreeable to the intent & meaning thereof----

Item: I will & bequeath to my Son Moses all the land that I now possess Between Calaways Upper Line Also I give to my Son Moses all Farming Tools that I now possess.

Item: I Will & Bequeath to my Son Aron all the lands that I now possess from Calaways Upper Line to Hawkins Branch, Excepting that part if the plantation whereon I now Live which I have already lent to my Wife During her Natural Life I then afterwards to my Will is that it should belong to Son Aron also I give to my Son Aron one Still with my Smiths Tools together with my Carpenter Tools also the Gun Tools also I give to my Son Aron one Bed & feniture with a Cloth Loom Three Hoochheads & large Oval Table Also I give to my Son Aron two Carts Also I give to my son-in-law Joseph Key one Shilling Sterling-----
