her two feather beds and furniture also One Bofat and crockery therein also  
one Loom and kithin furniture all the plantation tools also Do lend one Mare  
and Cart half Dozan Setting Chares and two tables also one Linen Wheel and one  
Coten Mashen one Wooling Wheel and Cards and one pair Smoothing Irons two Sows  
and pigs are given and one feather bed and furniture & bedstead given to My  
Daughter Nancy My Son Demacy H. Cahoon Do Give him one haffer also one Grind-  
stone one heffer yearlin to be left to my Son Daniel Cahoon - Lastly I Do  
Nominate and appoint My Loving Wife Polly Cahoon and Mr. David Ketchum My  
Executors to this my last Will and testament in witness Whereof I Set My hand

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In the Name of God Amen I Josiah Cox of the County of Onslow and State of  
North Carolian Being weak in body, But of Sound mind and memory; Calling to  
mind the mortality of my body; do make this my last will and testament in the  
following manner and form--

Imprimas I Give and bequeath to my Beloved Wife Margaret Cox five Negroes (Viz)  
Reddick Buck Prince Delala & Israel two Horses one Called Dick the other a yong  
mare Called Gin. Six cows & calves yong yoke of each two three year old steers.  
Riding Chair and Harness; and cart, all my plantation tools four sows & pigs  
fifteen year old hogs, six yews & lams all my geese, all my household and Kitchen  
furniture ( Except one feather bed and furniture) twenty five Bushels Wheat, all  
my Corn and fodder all my pork all my Bacon. ( Except three Hundred and fifty  
pounds) To her my Beloved wife her Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item: I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Wife two Hundred pounds of Seed Cotton  
all my flax and flax seeds all my peas and potato slips---

Item: I lend unto my wife during her Natural life all my Cleared land on the  
South and East side of Mulberry branch with the privilage of Cutting rail timber  
and fire wood on any of my lands. Also to Clear ten Acres the Sd. lands Including  
my Dwelling House and out Houses also I lend my wife a Negro Girl Hannah for the  
term of five years & one named Irma for Seven Years.-----

Item: My will and desire is that all my Just Debts and funeral Charges be paid  
out of the moneys I leave my Children-----

Item: My Willand desire is that my Executors rent out my Mills for the term of  
Seven years at the Hiest Bidder with the privilage of Cutting rail timber  
Sd. Mills and logs for sawing on any part of my lands for the term of Six years,  
the rent of Sd. Mills to be paid annually, and go as hereafter I shall direct---

Item: M<sup>y</sup> willand desire is that my Executors rent out the remainder of my  
Cleared lands one half to be tended of a year And six or seven acres of land to  
be Cleared along the line that divides my Upper piece of Land from the other  
Peirs,

Item: My will is that Easter Jayday and five small children stay on the  
plantation the present year.

Item: My will is that my Executors sell at six Months Credit the remainder part  
of my Horses and Stock of all kinds with one bed three hundred and fifty pounds  
of Bacon and the Ballance of my Wheat and Cotton-----

Item: My will is that my Wife Keep my Children the present Year Clear of Charges  
(Except Debby She is to be Bounded out at School out of my Childrens Money----

Item: The remainder of my Negroes that is not before given away to be Hired out  
annually-----

Item: I leave the Sd. Negroes that are not given away with Sales of my Property,  
Will of Negroes Rents of Mill's & lands Money Notes and Book Debts to be Equally  
Divided between all my Children as they severally come of age or marry; if my  
wife should be in a state of pregnancy at this time or at the time of my Death  
Sd. Child shall draw an equall share with rest either real or personal property  
to them their Heirs & assigns for ever-----

Item: My will is that my lands be rented out until my youngest Child comes of  
age or marries, and the money Equally Divided between all my Children and at  
the Expiration of Sd. time, I leave my lands to be equally divided between all  
my Children Male & female to them their Heirs and assigns forever.

Item: I do hereby Consyquie and appoint my Beloved wife Margaret Executrix and  
my Brother in Law List Ballard and Richard Shackelford Executors.-----

Item: I do hereby disannul all former Wills requests by me made ratifying this  
and no other to be my last will and testament whereunto I have set my hand and  
fixed my Seal this 19th day of March 1810, & the wor Hanner interlined before  
signed----

Onslow County. Weak in body but in my right mind and Memory do  
make this my last will and Testament I hereby Give my body to be Buried in a  
Decent Christian Manner and I recommend my Soul in the Hands of God who Gave it

Item: I lend to my Beloved Wife Chedene my Dwelling House and plantation all  
on this Side the Deep Bottom During her Natural Life or Widowhood Also My Whole  
Stock of Hogsse Cattle and Sheep as long as my Family Live together and then to  
be Equally Divided when my Youngest Child Comes of Age--

Item: I give to my Beloved Son William Capps my Dwelling House and plantation  
all on this Side the Deep Bottom at his Mothers Death or inter marriage--

Item: I give to my Beloved Son Casson Capps the other part of my land on the  
other Side of the Deep Bottom with one half of the Mill also one Bay Horse to  
him and his Heirs forever.

Item: I give to my Beloved Daughter Elizabeth Capps my Road plantation containing  
two Hundred and fifty Acres of Land to her and her assigns forever.

Item: I give to my Beloved Daughter Senlah Capps Seventy Eight acres of Land  
lying on Hicks Run with Seventy acres in another Track for privilage to her  
and her Heirs forever -----

Also one Canoe two Shoot guns and one Berpplow of Leave to be Sold at Public  
Sale also two Canoes in the Desert One pair of Large Stilliards to be sold.  
Also my Negro Man Tony and his wife Clary to be hired out together and  
the money to be put to Schoolin my Children and the rest to be kept on Interest  
and then Equally Divided among my Four Children When they Come of Age.

Also my Four negroes with all Their Increase to be Equally Divided By Lot among my Four Children when They all come of Age. Also of the Lands that I Leave to my Two Daughters to be rented out For Repair untill it is under good Repair then to be Rented to the Highest bidder The money to be Keep on Interest untill they Come of age Then to be Equally Divided among my Four Children I also Constitute and Appoint my Friend Lemuel Hardison and my son William Capps my sole and sole Executors to this my Last will and Testament In witness Hereunto I set my hand and Seal in the presence of us all October 26th 1823.

Item: I lend to daughter Elizabeth Meek one Feather bed And furniture during her life and after her Death I give the afo. bed and furniture and one Chest to Nancy Evan daughter of Elizabeth Meek to her and Her Heirs Forever----

Item: I give and bequeath to my Daughter Aliff Dixon one bed and furniture one large pewter Dish one green chest one linning Wheel & wooling Ditto One large pot and hooks & Urnall to her and Her forever----

Item: My Will and desire is that all my Stock of sheep and Hogs And bees be equally divided between my son and Daughter to Wm. Aaron and Aliff Dixon to them And their Heirs forever-----

Item: It is further my will and desire that after all my Just debts is paid that all the remaining part of my property Not before given away be sold and Equally Divided between all my Children-----  
And I hereby make and ordain my Sons Burrell and Aaron Dixon Executors of this my Last Will and testament in witness whereof I the Said Jonathan Dixon have to this my Last will and testament Set my hand and seal--

As to my Worldly Substance which God Hath Been Pleased to Bless me with, I desire it may disposed of in the manner & form Following-----  
ITEM: My Will is that my Debts be collected, and all the Just demands against me be satisfied and paid

ITEM: I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Eliza Smith a negro woman named Isabel & her increase to her own proper use, to dispose of by Will or otherwise have them out year by year in that manner as she may thin proper. or to sell them, if she sees caused so to do. In like manner to do with the rest of the property given her also that part of my estate which I shall after mention that is to say a Childs part---with her three children by Barber both real & Personal as hereafter Directed & division made.

ITEM: I give & Bequeath unto my son Daniel M. Dulany all of that tract or parcel of land whereon he now liveth, lying and being in the CC & State aforesaid on the South Side of the North East of New River agreeable to deed given unto me by Christopher Dudley Esq. for the said land with all the privileges & appurtenances to the same belonging --- I also give him my negro man Luke and boy Hercules ratifying all and singular what property hath been given him heretofore .

ITEM: I do hereby ratify and confirm all and singular what I gave my Well loved Daughter Ann M. Barden at her marriage and since further more I give and bequeath unto her her one negro woman named Anna boy Anthony and boy George also one fourth of the property to be divided and fourth of my cattle and sheep not other wise given .

ITEM: I do hereby ratify and confirm all and singular what I gave to my well Beloved daughter Rachel Ward at her marriage and one negro Woman named (Finnette) called Run with her three children and their increase forever. Also the young Sorrel mare My common dining table and one arme chair with one fourth what may be sold and of Cattle & Sheep.
