Item: I give and bequeath to my son Henry Dixon one Feather bed & furniture one chest to him and His Heirs forever-----

Item: I lend to daughter Elizabeth Meek one Feather bed And furniture during her life and after her Death I give the afo. bed and furniture and one Chest to Nancy Evan daughter of Elizabeth Meek to her and Her Heirs Forever----

Item: I give and bequeath to my Daughter Aliff Dixon one bed and furniture one large pewter Dish one green chest one linning Wheel & wooling Ditto One large pot and hooks & Urnall to her and Her forever----

Item: My Will and desire is that all my Stock of sheep and Hogs And bees be equally divided between my son and Daughter to Wm. Aaron and Aliff Dixon to them And their Heirs forever-----

Item: It is further my will and desire that after all my Just debts is paid that all the remaining part of my property Not before given away be sold and Equally Divided between all my Children-----
And I hereby make and ordain my Sons Burrell and Aaron Dixon Executors of this my Last Will and testament in witness whereof I the Said Jonathan Dixon have to this my Last will and testament Set my hand and seal--

In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Dulany Citizen of the County of Onslow & State of North Carolina do make and Constitute this my last Will & Testament revoking all others Wills Heretofore by me made. As to my Worldly Substance which God Hath Been Pleased to Bless me with, I desire it may disposed of in the manner & form Following-----
ITEM: My Will is that my Debts be collected, and all the Just demands against me be satisfied and paid

ITEM: I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Eliza Smith a negro woman named Isabel & her increase to her own proper use, to dispose of by Will or otherwise have them out year by year in that manner as she may thin proper. or to sell them, if she sees caused so to do. In like manner I shall after of the property given her also that part of my estate which I shall after mention that is to say a Childs part---with her three children by Barber both real & Personal as hereafter Directed & division made.

ITEM: I give & Bequeath unto my son Daniel M. Dulany all of that tract or parcel of land whereon he now liveth, lying and being in the CC & State aforesaid on the South Side of the North East of New River agreeable to deed given unto me by Christopher Dudley Esq. for the said land with all the privileges & appurtenances to the same belonging --- I also give him my negro man Luke and boy Hercules ratifying all and singular what property hath been given him heretofore .

ITEM: I do hereby ratify and confirm all and singular what I gave my Well loved Daughter Ann M. Barden at her marriage and since further more I give and bequeath unto her her one negro woman named Anna boy Anthony and boy George also one fourth of the property to be divided and fourth of my cattle and sheep not other wise given .

ITEM: I do hereby ratify and confirm all and singular what I gave to my well Beloved daughter Rachel Ward at her marriage and one negro Woman named (Finnette) called Run with her three children and their increase forever. Also the young Sorrel mare My common dining table and one arme chair with one fourth what may be sold and of Cattle & Sheep.

ITEM: I give unto my son Benjn. F. Dulany the land and plantation wherwon I now live, The sound plantation and land also with all the privilege to the same belonging According to the Tittles I hold each of them by- and three hundred and thirty four acres of land on both sides the great Swamp in said County as may appear by the tittles & I also give him the house wherein I now live with two best Beds & Funitur the house & Kitchen utensils, His brother John Gun Horse, & wearing apparel Putima Colt One yoke of Oxen all of the hogs, with Carts, Ploughs and all the plantation tools whatever two stocks of Bees, One hand Mill One half of Corn, Bacon & Pork on hand All the money due me after my debts is paid with one fourth of my Cattle & Sheep. I give And Bequeath to him the following negroes (to wit) Old Lucy, Harry Owen Esther and Increase and Cape. Notwithstanding the above bequest my Desire is tht B. F. Dulany be mentioned as Executor he may not be premitted to Act, nor able to give a right or title 'till he is twenty one years of age and then if he cares let him qualifie. My will is that the above now planting should be regulated and Devided as above.

ITEM: I give and bequeath unto my two Grand sons Thomas D. and John L. Barber, one Negro boy named Sanders Equally Devided between them when Thomas comes to the age of twenty five years. The boy Sanders to be hired out annually by Execu. hereafter named for schooling necessities as may be most needful For said Tho. & Jno. Barber if either should Decease before they come to the age of twenty one years the Sd. Sanders to be entirely the others. I also give each of them a Childs part with their Mother of the property left to be sold and Devided.

ITEM: I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Helen D. Barber fifty acres of Land in the fork of Wallace Creek I bot of Ben Keltor as by patent & Deed may appear also a Childs part with her brothers & Mother as above.

ITEM: My Will is further is the land on both sides of Wallices Creek of mine be sold also all the turpentine or hand Tar kiln. Brilliant, old riding chair and all my other property (Except Cattle & Sheep) be sold & Devided between Eliza & Children Danl. Ann & Rachel.

ITEM: I request that my burial may be with Common Decency and my Bones carried & laid by your Mother-- Lastly I hereby Constitute and appoint my two sons Dan A. Dulany and Ben. F. Dulany Executors of this my last will and testament, utterly revoking all others wille heretofore by me made, declaring this to be my last will. I Thomas Dudley of Onslow County Planter being in low state of health but of perfect mind and memory and Calling to recollection the uncertainty of life do make and ordain this my last Will and testament in form and manner following (viz) after my death it is my will and desire that my body be decently Interred in the family burying ground by my Executors. And that all my real estate be sold on a Credit of six and twelve months and the perishable part on credit of six months (except such as my hereafter otherwise be disposed of) and the moneys arising therefrom after paying all my just debts to be put out at Interest which shall be subject to an equal division among my four Children, (to wit) Eley, Thomas, Eliza and Chrissy Dudley Share and Share alike Whenever they shall arrive at the age of Twenty years or shall marry-- but should it so happen that either of them should die before arriving at that age or marrying then the property to be equally divided between the Survivors.

ITEM: I give and bequeath to my Daughter Cassy Cowell Seventy one acres of land on Whitlock River be the same more or less it being a Tract of land formerly owned by Ezekiel Hunter, one feather bed and furniture One round Mahogany Tea Table one Negro Girl named Charlotte all of which she has now in her possession also onemore feather bed and furniture which is at present in my House to her heirs and assigns forever--

ITEM: I give and bequeath to my daughter Eley Dudley one feather bed and furniture, one looking glass and one Chest which was her motheres to her and her heirs and assigns forever--

ITEM: I give and bequeath to my Son Thomas Dudley one feather bed and furniture and one chest to him and his heirs forever.

ITEM: I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza Dudley one feather bed and furniture and one looking glass, and one trunk to her and her heirs forever.

ITEM: I give and bequeath to my daughter Chrissy Dudley, One feather bed and furniture one looking Glass and one trunk to her and her heirs forever. & furthermore it is my Will and desire that my two daughters Eliza and Chrissy & furthermore education at the discretion of my Executors. Let it also be remembered that my table linen and such part of my table and furniture as my four children may want (VIZ) Eley Thomas Eliza and Chrissy be put at a fair Valuation and charge to their separate Accounts. hereby nominating and appointing John H. Hill, Charles Carroll and my son Thomas Dudley (when he shall arrive at the age of Twenty) Executors to this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all others as witnesses my hand and seal This Twenty Sixth Day of November in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eleven.
